

CHLORINE STABILIZER - WHY USE THIS PRODUCT:

When the chlorine in pool water is stabilized, sanitizing action is prolonged because less of the chlorine is lost due to sunlight, rain and other environmental factors. Therefore the frequency of routine chlorinating is reduced, as well as the amount of chlorinator needed.

If you use a stabilized chlorinator for routine sanitizing — such as POOL TIME 1" or 3" TABLETS or POOL TIME GRANULAR CHLORINATING CONCENTRATE — you will probably need to add CHLORINE STABILIZER only once at the beginning of each season. Stabilized chlorinators replenish stabilizer lost through backwashing or splash-out.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Read entire label and use strictly in accordance with precautionary statements and directions.

- Stabilizer level should be a minimum of 30 ppm.
- Before adding this product, backwash or clean filter.
- Test and balance water before using this product. Visit www.pooltime.com for complete pool balancing instructions.

APPLICATION METHODS:

- If your pool has a deep end, broadcast product throughout the deep end. Brush any undissolved product from pool surface.
- If your pool does not have a deep end, apply product through the skimmer. First remove any items from skimmer basket and place in a non-bleachable area away from children and pets. SLOWLY add product directly into the skimmer with the filter and pump operating.
- For fresh filled pools, add 1 lb per 4,000 gallons.
- At pool opening, test stabilizer. If stabilizer level is below 30 ppm, add 1 lb per 4,000 gallons.
- After adding this product, keep water circulating continuously for 24 hours. When the chemical reaches the filter, there may be a temporary increase in filter pressure which will cease as the chemical dissolves.
- AFTER ADDING this product, DO NOT BACKWASH FILTER for at least 48 hours.
