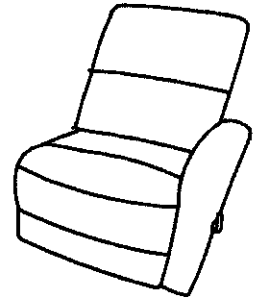


Recliner Assembly Instructions

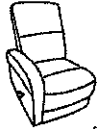

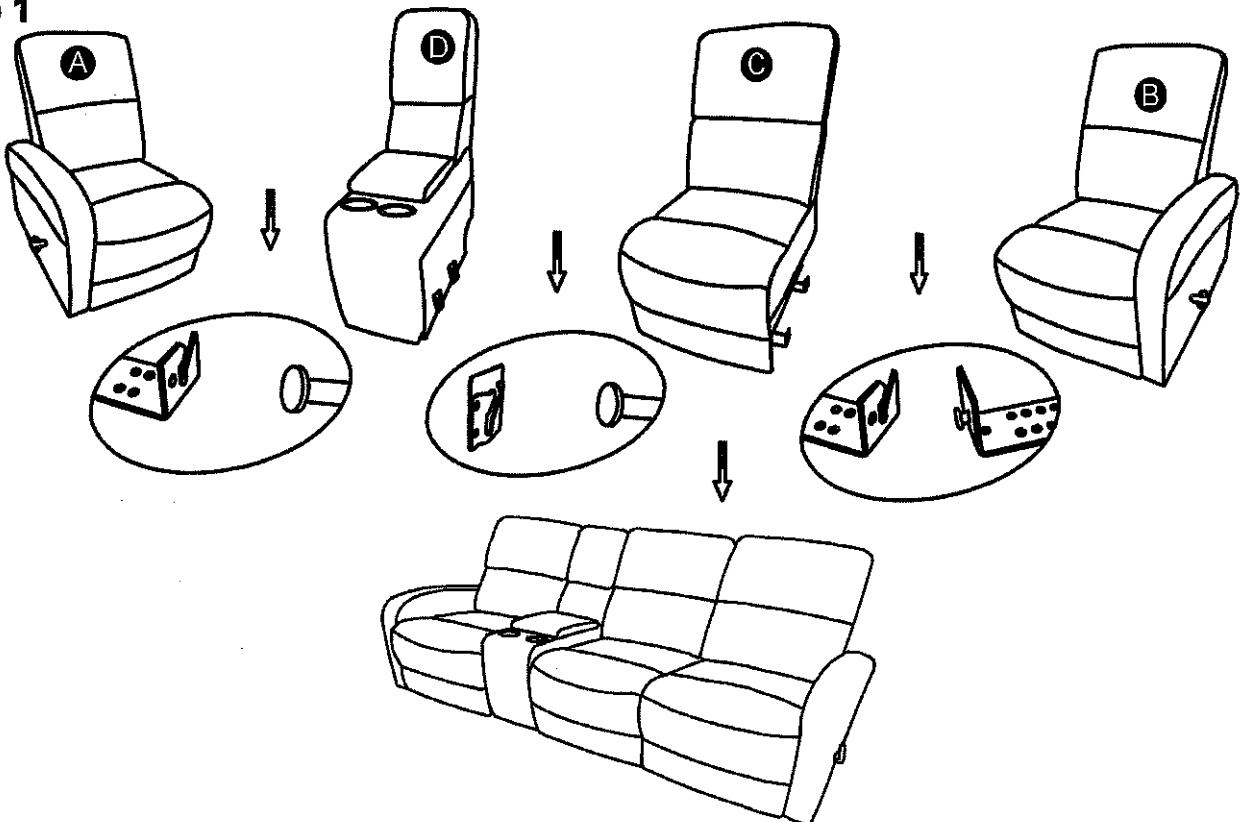
