PREPARATION

- Always wear work shoes and long trousers while working with the machine. Don't operate the machine barefoot or in open sandals. Don't wear clothing that has loose parts or hanging laces or neckties.
- Always use effective ear protection and safety goggles
- Carefully inspect the area where the machine will be used and remove any objects that the machine may discard.
- Before starting the machine, make sure that all bolts, nuts and other fastenings are properly tightened and that guards and shields are in correct place. Replace damaged or illegible labels.

- Prior to use, check the power supply and the extension lead for signs of damage or aging. If the supply is damaged during use, unplug the power supply immediately. DO NOT TOUCH THE SUPPLY BEFORE DISCONNECTING THE POWER. Don't use the machine if the supply is damaged or worn.
- Cable drum before using completely unwind.
- Use only extension cables with sufficient section, which are approved for this purpose and labelled accordingly.

(j) Note: It is good to have the extension cable in a distinctive colour in order to not to overlook, cross, cut through or trip over it.

- Use the machine in the recommended position and only on a firm, level surface.
- Don't operate the machine on a paved or gravel surface where the discarded material could cause injury.

OPERATION

- Only operate the machine in daylight or in good artificial light.
- Avoid using the machine on wet grass.
- Always make sure you have a steady stance on the slope.
- Always walk, never run.
- Work across the slope, never up and down.
- Move extremely cautiously if you change direction on the slope.
- Don't operate the machine on slopes that are too steep.
- Take extra care if you are reversing or pulling the machine towards you.
- Stop the sharp edges if the machine is to be tilted when passing over a surface other than the lawn and when the machine is transported to or from the mowing site.
- Never operate a machine that has damaged protective covers or protectors or has no safety devices, such as deflectors and/or collecting basket.
- Connect the engine carefully in accordance with the operating instructions and stay away from the sharp edges.
- Don't tilt the machine when the engine is being switched on, unless the machine has to be tilted when starting. In this case, don't tilt it more than necessary and only lift only the part that is remote from the operator. Always hold both hands in the working position before placing the machine back on the ground.
- Don't run the machine when standing in front of the borehole.
- Don't put your hands or feet near or below rotating parts. Never stand in front of the borehole.
- Don't carry the machine while the engine is running.
- Stop the machine and disconnect the plug from the socket (and remove the locking device if installed). Make sure that all moving parts have completely stopped.
 - whenever you leave the machine,
 - before cleaning a clogged channel,
 - before checking, cleaning or working on the machine,
 - after passing over a foreign object. Make sure that the machine isn't damaged and repair it before restarting and operating;
- If the machine starts to vibrate excessively (check immediately)
 - look for damage,
 - replace or repair any damaged parts,
 - check that all loose parts are tightened.



PERSONAL PROTECTION AND FIRST AID

(i) Note: we recommend always having:

- A suitable fire extinguisher (snow, powder, halotron) at your disposal.
- A fully equipped first-aid kit, easily accessible for accompaniment and operator.
- Mobile phone or other device for quickly calling emergency services.
- Accompaniment familiar with the principles of first aid.

Accompaniment must keep a safe distance from the workplace while always seeing you!

- Always follow the principles of first aid in case of any injuries.
- If there is a cut, cover the wound with a clean bandage (fabric) and press down firmly to stop the bleeding.

- Dangers caused by shooting up of subjects or splashing of liquids.

WARNING! The product produces an electromagnetic field of a very weak intensity. This field may interfere with some pacemakers. To reduce the risk of serious or fatal injury, persons with pacemakers should consult the use with their physician and the manufacturer.

ELECTRICAL REQUIREMENTS

 Never use at the nominal voltage other than 120V/60HZ. The circuit must be properly and accordingly current protected.

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR PROTECTION CLASS II MACHINES

• Machines should be powered via a current protector (RCD) having a tripping current of no more than 30 mA.

UNPACKING

- Carefully remove the product from the box.
- Do not throw away packaging materials until you have reviewed carefully that they did not remain any parts of the product.
- Parts of the packaging (plastic bags, paper clips, etc.) do not leave within reach of children, could be a possible source of danger. Do not let children play with plastic bags, foils or small parts. There is a danger of swallowing or suffocating!
- Make sure that bags and containers of plastic material are disposed of properly in the environment because they pollute it.
- Disposal must be made in accordance with the regulations in force in the country in which the product was installed.

PACKAGE CONTENTS:

1x scarifier body, 2x lower part of the handle, 1x middle part of the handle, 4x screw with nut, 1x upper part of the handle, 1x collection box cover, 1x collection box frame, 1x cable restraint, 2x cable clamp, 1x second working cylinder, 1x instruction manual

- Standard accessories are subject to change without notice.
- This product requires assembly. The product must be assembled correctly before use.
- If you notice transport damage or while unpacking, notify your supplier immediately. Do not

ASSEMBLY

- Put the lower handle *(fig. 2)* into the socket and insert into the lock on the body of the machine *(fig. 3)*. The connection secure by quick screw in the "open" position. Then "lock it" in a suitable position.
- To the middle part of the handle put the cable restraint (*fig.* 4(3)). Then screw the handle by using two quick screws (*fig.* 4(3)) to the lower parts of the handle.
- To the middle part of the handle fix by using two quick screws (*fig.* 4()) to the upper part of the handle.
- At the end fasten the cable by using the clips to the handle (fig. 5).

GRASS COLLECTING BAG

- Mount the collection box cover on the frame (fig. 6(A))
- Pull the safety flap upwards and hold.
- Attach the holder of the collecting bag to the hooks onto the housing (fig. 6(B)).

WORKING WITH THE DEVICE

A CAUTION! The machine is designed for loading only by moving forward. By moving backwards, first stop the shaft with blades. By moving backwards the collection does not work and the machine can be damaged.

BEFORE STARTING

MOUNTING OF THE EXTENSION CABLE

- Thread the extension cable through the strain relief as a loop and hang it up (fig. 7(A)).
- Plug the female connector of the extension cable on the male connector of the machine (*fig.* 7(3)).
- Make sure that the extension cable has enough free motion.

SWITCHING ON

WARNING! The blade starts turning as soon as the motor is started.

Start the motor carefully according to instructions and with body parts, especially feet well away from the blade.

Start the aerator on a level surface, free of high grass or obstacles. Keep hands and feet away from the rotating parts. Do not start the motor when standing in front of the discharge opening. During operation, always hold the handle and switch handle firmly with both hands.

- The device is equipped with a safety circuitry preventing inadvertent switching on.
- Tilt the appliance slightly towards you so that the front wheels are above the ground and the roll could start running smoothly.
- Push the safety button (fig. 8(A)) and keep it depressed.
- Next, pull the switch lever (fig. 8 (B)) against handle bar.
- The machine starts and the drum can rotate freely.
- Now release the safety button *(fig. 8*(A)).
- () Note: During operation, when the switch handle is released, the motor will stop and thus stopping the lawn aerator from operating.

SWITCHING OFF

- \triangle CAUTION! The cylinder continues to rotate for a few seconds after the motor is shut off.
- Release the switch lever and motor will stop (fig. 8 B).

MOTOR PROTECTION

- The motor is equipped with a protective circuit breaker and switches off automatically in case of overloading. After a cooling down break (approx. 15 min), the motor may be restarted.
- Release the switch lever (*fig. 8* (b)) because the device will otherwise restart immediately after it has cooled down. Risk of injury!

SETTING THE WORK DEPTH

CAUTION! Before settings the work depth switch off device and wait until the drum is stationary!

All wheels must be set to the same height.

- The cutting height is adjusted directly by the shift switch *(fig. 9*(A)) on the front of the deck.
- Pull the lever in the direction indicated by the arrow (*fig. 9* (b)) and set it to the desired position (0/1/2/3/4). Ensure that the lever clicks into place correctly.
- When you set the working depth, start with the smallest depth (position 1) to bigger depth. After each change try to drive a little piece of the lawn. When the drum contacts the ground, stop setting the working depths. If the lawn is rough and aerating is uneven, you can lower the depth after one degree.
- For the first aerating we recommend you to set the lowest depth.
- If you don't observe this instructions, there is a risk of overload and machine damage. In case
 of using raker drum in extremely low position there is an additional chipping or cracking
 of the wire. The lowest positions are for work with partially worn (shorter) blades / wires.

GRASS CATCHER

A CAUTION! Risk of injury! Only remove or attach the grass collection box with the motor switched off and the blade stationary.

If the grass catcher is full, should be promptly emptied.

Empty and clean the grass sack or grass basket, make sure it is clean and ensure its meshwork is ventilated.

CHANGING THE DRUMS

CAUTION! Before changing the drums switch off device wait until the drum is stationary pull out main plug.

- 1. Loosen the pan head screws (*fig. 11*(A)) at the seat of the bearing.
- 2. Lift the scarifier drum at the seat of the bearing and pull it out.
- 3. Push the protrusion of the aerator drum into the drive opening.
- 4. Remount the seat of the bearing using the screws (fig. 12(A)).

DECK

The underside of the mower deck should be cleaned after each use to prevent a buildup of grass clippings, leaves, dirt or other matter. If this debris is allowed to accumulate, it will invite rust and corrosion, and may prevent proper operating.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

WHY IS TILLING NECESSARY?

Various climatic seasons in the year lead to storing dead and dry grass and moss, which results in the grass getting felty. The grass roots are unable then to absorb nutrients, water and air in sufficient quantities. The lawn is withering. Vertical cut opens the soil, removes felty places and conditions of better supply of nutrients are thus given.

HOW TO TILL?

On a grassy area with strong felty places, it is necessary to till along once and across once. These works should be done twice in a year. The most suitable is the period in spring, when the soil is not frozen in last summer until the end of September. Later tilling should not be done for the lawn to be prepared possibly for resistance of the lawn in severe winter. In any case, the ejected material should be removed from the grassy area. Tillers for private house garden are those the annual use of which do not exceed 50 hours and are used mainly to care of the grass and grassy areas, but not in public facilities, parks, sports grounds, in agriculture and forestry.

▲ CAUTION! If you strike a foreign object, stop the motor. Disconnect the power cord, thoroughly inspect the aerator for any damage and repair the damage before restarting and operating the aerator. Extensive vibration of the aerator during operation is an indication of damage (especially cylinder and shaft). The aerator should be promptly inspected and repaired. Contact an authorized service center.

AERATING

- We recommend you to aerate your lawn at the spring and autumn. Do not aerate during lawn dormancy in any case!
- To enable the growth of a healthy lawn in spring, the absorption of water, air and nutrients in the root area needs to be increased.
- To achieve good results and to extent the life of the scarifier drum, the lawn should be mowed before scarifying (shorter than 4 cm).
- Place the scarifier at the edge of the lawn near the receptacle. Move the cable after each turn to the opposite already scarified side *(fig. 10)*.
- Select the work depths according to the condition of the lawn (see "Setting the work depth").
- In case of uncultivated very mossy lawn, move once more across to the rows setting the work depth then to a higher position.
- When working on slopes, always position yourself perpendicular to the incline and ensure safe footing. Do not scarify on steep slopes.
- Empty the grass catching bag when it is full to prevent the blades from being blocked and subsequently the motor from being overloaded.



- Mow the lawn once more after scarifying. •
- Reseed blank spots that may have developed after scarifying.
- Fertilize the lawn only after fresh grass seeds have put down roots.

MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE

A CAUTION! To ensure proper functioning of the machine, it is necessary to have it checked and adjusted by qualified personnel in an authorized service centre at least once a year.

Good maintenance is essential for safe, economical and trouble-free operation.

Failure to properly follow maintenance instructions and precautions can cause you to be seriously hurt or killed. Always follow the procedures and precautions in this owner's manual.

WARNING! Prior to any work on the machine (maintenance, inspection, replacement) of accessories, servicing) or before storing it, ALWAYS SWITCH THE ENGINE OFF, wait for all moving parts to stop and allow the machine to cool down. Prevent the engine from being started accidentally (disconnect the power unit from the mains). If the machine is equipped with a trigger key, remove it.

THIS WARNING IS NOT REPEATED IN ANY FOLLOWING POINTS!

- Always make sure that all nuts and bolts are firmly tightened and make sure the machine is in aood working order.
- Keep the machine in good condition, if necessary change warning and instruction labels on the machine.
- Always ensure that the ventilation openings are kept clear of debris.
- For safety reasons, replace worn or damaged parts. Only use original spare parts and accessories. Parts not tested and approved by the equipment manufacturer can cause unforeseeable damage.
- Repair and maintenance work other than described in this section, which are more complicated, or it needs special tools, let it on our authorized service.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR MACHINE MAINTENANCE

- Frequently check the collection basket for wear or damage.
- Always be careful when adjusting the machine to avoid jamming fingers between moving sharp edges and rigid machine parts.
- If you are repairing a set of sharp edges, be aware that even though the power is switched off, the blades can still be moving.

CLEANING

🔨 CAUTION! Never spray the product with water or expose it to water. In any case, do not wash by water the parts of machine, which are not intended for it.

Never use aggressive detergents or solvents for cleaning.

1. Carefully clean the machine after each use.



- 2. Do not let the handles contaminate with oil or grease. Clean the handle with a damp cloth washed in soapy water. Never use aggressive detergents or solvents for cleaning. This can cause irreparable damage to the product. The plastic parts can be eaten away by chemicals.
- 3. Wipe down the product with a slightly damp cloth or with brush.
- 4. Clean the cover of the machine, especially the ventilation holes.
- 5. If any of the parts of the machine is cleaned by water or a damp cloth, etc., it must be completely dry. Then the metal parts must be greased against the corrosion with suitable protective oil. Make sure that the water doesn't leak into the internal parts of the machine.
- 6. Potential damage of the parts due to corrosion, can not be assessed as a manufacturing or material defect.
- 7. After use, clean the outside of the machine, empty the grass-catcher and shake it to remove grass and other debris.
- 8. Clean the bottom of the aerator and all used cylinders.
- 9. Clean wheels, coat of clay can change the depth of cut.
- 10. When handling with working cylinders wear protective gloves.

REPAIRS

Expert inspection is required, do not make any adjustment by yourself, must contact authorized service centre:

- A. If the lawn aerator strikes an object.
- B. If the motor stops suddenly.
- C. If the cylinder is bent (do not align!).
- D. If the motor shaft is bent (do not align!).
- E. If a short-circuit occurs when the cable is connected.
- F. When you are unsure or the problems are not described here.

STORAGE

- Store the machine out of reach of children.
- Turn the motor off and disconnect the mains plug if the machine is not used.
- Allow let the machine to cool down before storage.
- Do not store the machine a long time in direct sunlight.
- Replace worn or damaged parts for safety.
- Store machine in a clean, dry, dark and frost-free place, protected from dust and out of reach of children. The ideal storage temperature is between 5 and 30°C.
- Use the original packaging for storage whenever possible.
- Cover unit with a suitable protective cover that does not retain moisture. Do not use sheet plastic as a dust cover. A nonporous cover will trap moisture around the machine, promoting rust and corrosion.

TRANSPORT

- When moving the machine, the cylinder must be disengaged and the aeration deck raised as high as possible.
- Turn the motor off and disconnect the mains plug. When transporting, be careful not to drop, or otherwise shock the machine. For transport, the machine has to be fixed against slipping and tipping over. Do not place objects on the machine.
- The drum can be damaged during transport, e.g. on hard ground, even when the motor is switched off. Therefore set the work depth of the drum to highest position during transport.
