



Please have the following information ready when you make your call:


- Model Number of the product located on the frond of the assembly manual

- Keep these instructions for future reference.






Care and Cleaning

- 1.For best results, clean the pergolas with a damp cloth and dry thoroughly. This will help prevent mildew by removing dirt particles that may accumulate.
- 2.Do not clean with abrasive materials, bleach, or solvents.
- 3. Store the pergolas in a dry, sheltered place when not in use.
- 4. Keep the pergolas away from fire, extreme heat, freezing conditions, and inclement weather such as rain, hail, sleet, snow, or wind.
