Lagerstroemia hybrid 'JD818' PP22697

Early Bird Crapemyrtles begin blooming as early as Mother's Day, much earlier than other summer-blooming crapemyrtles, then rebloom for 100-120 days of color.

USE

Accent, hedge, container

BLOOM / BLOOM TIME

Lavender blooms late spring through fall

GROWTH RATE

Moderate to fast

WATER

Medium water

SOIL

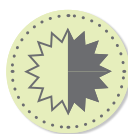
Well-drained garden soil with rich organic matter

FERTILIZE

Yearly in early spring
