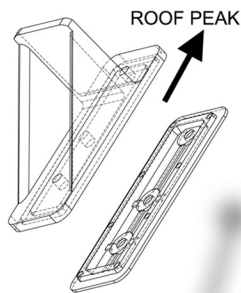

THE MINI

1. Installing with the *Perfect Seal Gasket System* makes installation safe and easy. Simply place the gasket in the grooved channel on the base of the Snow Guard, aligning up the screw holes. Set the Snow Guard in place to be screwed down. The standing flat side of the Snow Guard should be facing the peak of the roof.
2. Using three Neoprene Washered #10 sheet metal screws, attach the Snow Guard into a structural support (Example: perlin, sub-roof). Check for good compression of the gasket around the perimeter.
