How to Use – Outdoors

As a Perimeter Treatment	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Apply early in the season or when insects appear.• Apply in a band up to 7 feet wide around the outside perimeter of the building. Also treat the building foundation to a height of 2 feet where pests are active and may find entrance. Thoroughly and uniformly wet the band area.• Concentrate treatment at visible ant trails as well as cracks or crevices where ants may enter the structure• The surface to be treated should be dry at the time of application
Carpenter Ants	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Apply as a perimeter treatment as described above• For best results, locate and treat ant nests• Do NOT treat firewood

How to Use – Indoors

Conventional Pump Trigger Sprayer:

General Information: Turn sprayer nozzle to “on” position. Squeeze trigger to spray until surface is slightly moist but not to the point of runoff. Over application may cause damage. Test in an inconspicuous area before applying.

USE RESTRICTIONS

Do not treat pets with this product.

- Applications to building foundations, up to a maximum height of 2 feet.

Other than applications to building foundations, all outdoor applications to impervious surfaces including sidewalks, driveways, patios, porches and structural surfaces (including windows, doors, and eaves) are limited to spot and crack-and-crevice applications, only.

Do not water the treated area to the point of run-off.

Do not make applications during rain.

Application is prohibited directly into sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow this product to enter any drain during or after application.

FIRST AID

If swallowed
