

Blackout Curtains

Instructions / Assembly Guide

Thank you for choosing these blackout curtains. This guide provides general installation, care, and safety instructions applicable to most blackout curtain styles sold on the Home Depot platform. Please read all instructions carefully before installation.

Tools Needed

- Measuring tape
- Curtain rod and mounting brackets
- Drill or screwdriver
- Pencil for marking
- Step ladder (if needed)

Installation Instructions

Step 1 – Measure the Window

Measure the width and height of your window. For optimal blackout coverage, choose a curtain rod that extends beyond the window frame by 4–8 inches on each side.

Step 2 – Install Curtain Rod Brackets

Mark bracket locations evenly above the window frame. Secure the brackets firmly using appropriate wall anchors and screws for your wall type.

Step 3 – Prepare the Curtain Panels

Remove packaging and gently shake out folds or wrinkles. Iron or steam on low heat if needed.

Step 4 – Hang the Curtains

Slide the curtain rod through the rod pocket or grommets, depending on your curtain style. Mount the rod onto the installed brackets securely.

Step 5 – Adjust and Style

Spread panels evenly across the rod and adjust folds for a smooth appearance. Use tiebacks if included.

Care & Maintenance

- Machine wash cold on gentle cycle unless otherwise stated on the product label.
- Use mild detergent only.
- Do not bleach.
- Tumble dry low or air dry.
- Iron on low heat if necessary.
- Avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight to preserve color and fabric quality.

Safety Information

- Keep plastic packaging away from children and pets.
- Ensure curtain rods and brackets are securely installed before use.
- Do not allow children to climb or hang on curtain panels or rods.
- Use proper wall anchors when installing into drywall or masonry surfaces.
