

# Step Stones – Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

## 1. Dimensions & Weight

**Q: How much does each paver/stepping stone weigh?**

A: The weight varies by size and material. For example, a standard 12"x12" concrete paver typically weighs between 15–23 lbs. Always check the product specifications or ask your supplier for the exact weight.

**Q: What is the thickness of these pavers?**

A: Thickness can range from 1.5" to 2" or more, depending on the product. Refer to the product description for precise measurements.

**Q: How many pavers/stepping stones are on a pallet or in a box?**

A: The quantity per pallet or box is listed on the product page or packaging. Common counts are 42, 78, or 84 pieces per pallet, but this varies by manufacturer and size.

**Q: How many pavers do I need for my project?**

A: Calculate the area to be covered and divide by the coverage per paver. For example, a 24' x 24' patio will require more pavers than a 10' x 10' shed base. Product pages often include coverage calculators.

A: Use sand or polymeric sand between pavers for stability and weed prevention. Spacing recommendations vary; typically, leave 1/8" to 1/4" gaps.

**Q: Are these reinforced with mesh or rebar?**

A: Some products include internal reinforcement for added strength. Check product details or ask your supplier.

### 4. Purchasing & Availability

**Q: Can I buy pavers individually, or do I have to buy a full pallet?**

A: Availability varies by retailer. Some stores offer individual pieces, while others require pallet purchases. Ask your local store or check online listings.

**Q: How much does each paver or pallet cost?**

A: Prices vary by size, material, and region. Check the product page or contact your retailer for current pricing.

**Q: Are these available for delivery or pickup?**

A: Most retailers offer both options. Minimum order quantities may apply for delivery.
