## Create a My Leviton Residence

Download the My Leviton App to your iOS or Android device and create your account to begin the set up of your smart home.

## Adding a Decora Smart Device

Add your Decora Smart device by selecting from the menu or scanning the product barcode on the package. Repeat and continue this process until all installed Decora Smart Wi-Fi products have been set up.

## **Create a Schedule**

Creating a schedule allows you to set your lights, fans and other small appliances to automatically turn on and off at specific times. You can set up one or multiple schedules that activate one or more Decora Smart Wi-Fi devices at a time. If a schedule is turned ON, it will run automatically until it is turned OFF.

# **Command Multiple Devices with Activities**

Creating an activity allows you to set your lights, fans and other small appliances to automatically activate upon command. You can set up one or multiple activities that include one or more Decora Smart Wi-Fi devices at a time. The activity will only run if the assigned icon is pressed or by voice command using a voice assistant.
