

Bathroom Door / Bathtub Door Installation Guide

Thank you for purchasing our bathroom door or bathtub door. Please read this installation guide carefully before beginning. Improper installation may result in damage or personal injury.

Tools Required:

- Measuring tape
- Level
- Screwdriver (Phillips and flat-head)
- Drill with bits
- Silicone sealant and applicator
- Rubber mallet
- Protective gloves and eyewear

Preparation:

1. Carefully unpack and inspect all components. Do not attempt installation if any part is missing or damaged.
2. Ensure that the installation area is clean, dry, and level.
3. Double-check that the wall structure can support the door assembly.

Installation Steps:

1. Position the bottom track at the desired location. Ensure it is level before fixing.
2. Mark and drill holes for the track anchors. Secure the bottom track using screws provided.
3. Install the side rails vertically, aligning them with the bottom track.
4. Attach the top track, ensuring all components are aligned and level.
5. Carefully place the glass panels or door panels into the bottom and top tracks.
6. Secure panels using the provided rollers, brackets, or hinges depending on your model.
7. Check door movement to ensure smooth sliding or swinging operation.
8. Apply silicone sealant along the edges to prevent water leakage.
9. Allow the sealant to cure fully before using the shower or bathtub area.

Safety Notes:

- Wear safety gear during installation.
- Do not overtighten screws to avoid damage.

- Handle glass panels with care to prevent breakage.
- Ensure the door is properly secured before first use.

Maintenance:

Clean the glass and frame regularly with mild soap and water. Avoid abrasive cleaners that can damage the surface. Inspect seals and rollers periodically and replace if worn.
