

Headboard Modification Plate

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1

Place assembled bed frame in front of headboard and position modi plate to determine which slots will line up with headboard brackets and headboard. Use provided lock nuts and bolts to attach modi plates to bedframe headboard brackets as shown in figure 1.

STEP 2

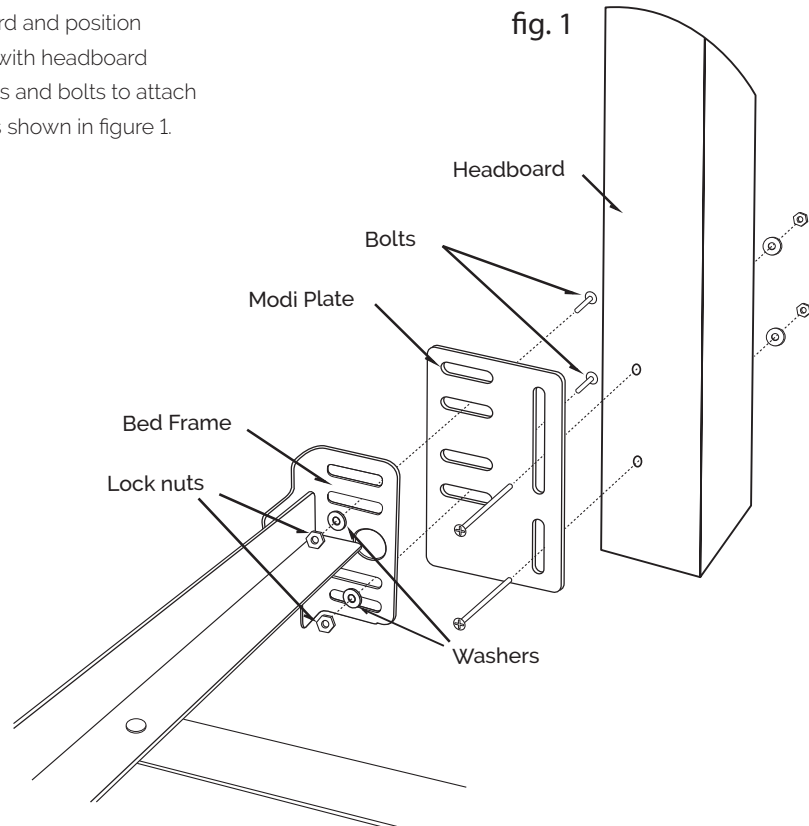
Use provided lock nuts and bolts to attach headboard.

- (H) Wall Mount x2
- (I) Screws x16
- (J) Drywall Anchor x8
- (K) Hex key

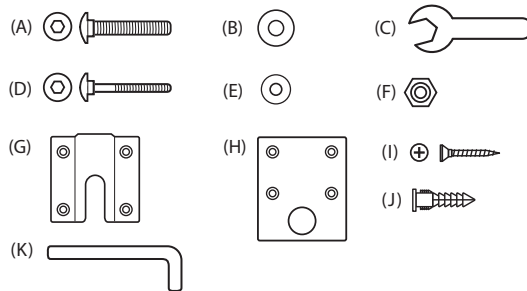
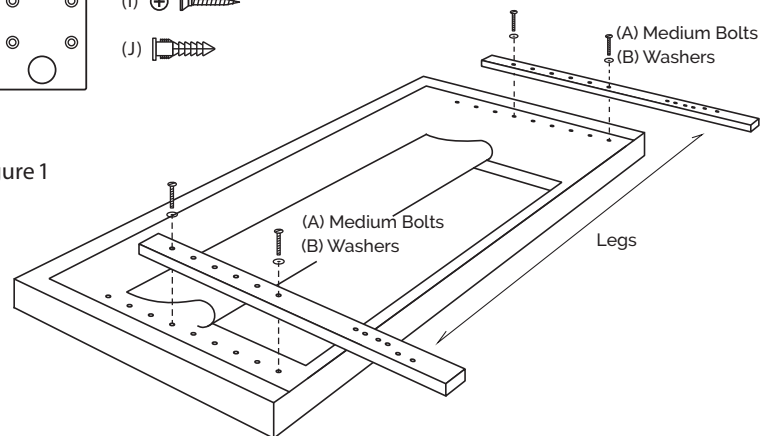

STEP ONE

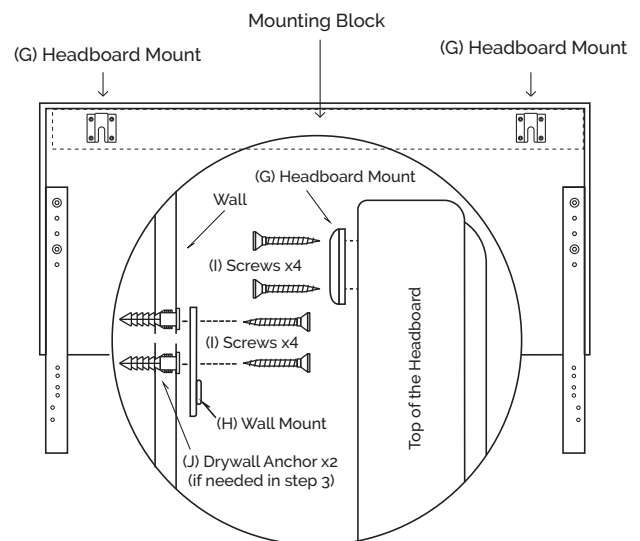
Remove the headboard from the box and lay it face down on the ground. Open the velcro panel on the back and remove both the legs and hardware.



STEP TWO

Using two (A) M8 bolts, two (B) washers and the provided holes, secure both legs to the headboard at your desired height with the hex key provided. (see Figure 1)

STEP 3 (recommended)

Using the mounting blocks on the back of your headboard, screw the two (G) headboard mounts to the top of your headboard with the provided (I) screws. Using the remaining (I) screws, attach the (H) wall mounts to your wall. Make sure to place the wall mounts at the correct height to pair with your previously installed (G) headboard mounts (see figure 2). If no wall studs are available to secure the headboard to your wall, use the provided (J) drywall anchors instead. Lift the headboard and lower into place to join the (G) and (H) mounts together.

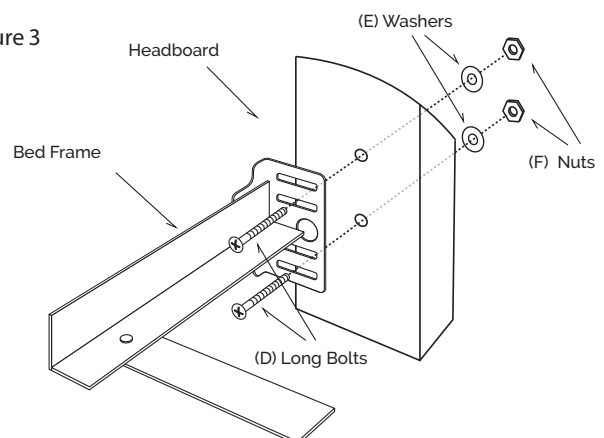
STEP 4

With the front side of the headboard facing the bed frame, attach the headboard to the frame using the (D) M6 bolts, (E) washers and (F) nuts.

If your bed frame doesn't fit the headboard, use the provided modification plates to secure the bed frame to the headboard. More instructions are included with the plates.
