

Bathroom Glass Shelf Installation Guide

This guide is for the 2-piece bathroom glass shelf set (tempered glass with aluminum guardrails, one with an integrated towel bar). Please read all steps carefully before installation to ensure safety and stability. The product is heavy-duty, rust-proof, and waterproof, suitable for bathroom use. Installation hardware for concrete walls is included.

Tools & Hardware Included

- 2 tempered glass shelves (1 with integrated towel bar)
- Aluminum mounting brackets (matching the shelves)
- Mounting screws and anchors (for concrete walls)
- Screwdriver (prepare separately if not included)

Installation Steps

1. **Choose Installation Position:** Select a flat, dry area on the bathroom wall (avoid damp corners or uneven surfaces). Mark the desired height for both shelves (ensure they are level; use a level tool if available).
2. **Drill Holes:** Align the mounting brackets with the marked positions. Use a drill to make holes in the concrete wall according to the size of the anchors. Clean the dust in the holes after drilling.
3. **Install Anchors:** Insert the included anchors into the drilled holes, tap gently with a hammer until they are flush with the wall surface.
4. **Fix Brackets:** Place the mounting brackets over the anchors, then use a screwdriver to tighten the screws, securing the brackets firmly to the wall. Ensure the brackets are level and stable.
5. **Install Shelves:** Carefully place the tempered glass shelves onto the mounted brackets. Adjust slightly to ensure they fit snugly. The guardrails should face upward to prevent items from falling.
6. **Check Stability:** After installation, gently shake the shelves to confirm they are secure. Ensure the towel bar (on one shelf) is firmly attached and can bear the weight of towels.

Safety & Maintenance Tips

- Do not install on non-concrete walls (e.g., drywall) without additional hardware; this may cause instability.

- Do not exceed the shelf's weight capacity; avoid placing heavy items to prevent glass breakage.
- Clean the shelves with a soft cloth and mild detergent; avoid abrasive cleaners to protect the matte finish and glass surface.
- Regularly check the screws and brackets for tightness, especially in humid bathroom environments.

If you encounter installation issues, ensure all steps are followed correctly. The product's rust-proof and waterproof features ensure long-term use in the bathroom.
