SET-UP INSTRUCTIONS

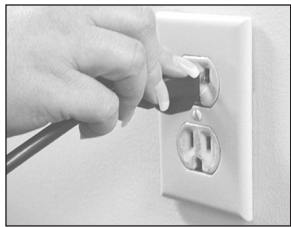

Please read all instructions for REST AIRE® and Simmons® Attached Pump prior to inflation.

1. Carefully unpack contents of carton.
2. Remove REST AIRE® from its convenient duffel bag.
3. Place mattress in unobstructed area free of sharp objects and unfold.

NOTE: Read separate Attached Pump instructions prior to operation.

4. Plug inset pump into a grounded 120 volt AC electrical outlet.
5. Make sure the valve is closed tightly. Valve is located to the left of the pump.

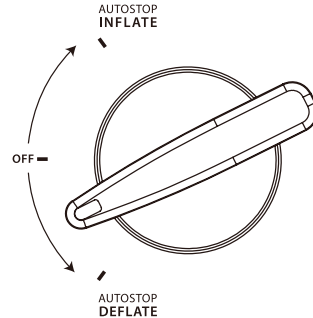
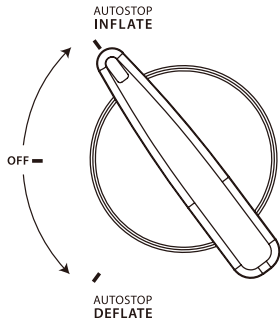

6. Inflate mattress by turning knob from OFF position to INFLATE position. Once fully inflated, pump will automatically stop.
7. To achieve desired firmness level, lie on the REST AIRE® mattress and turn mattress knob slowly towards the deflate position. (If too much air escapes, turn knob to inflate position.) Turn the dial back to OFF position when the mattress has reached your desired firmness level.



NOTE: Do not turn knob all the way to the deflate position or mattress will begin deflation process

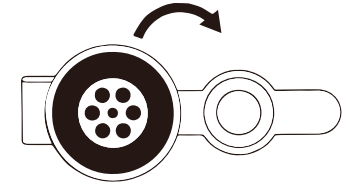
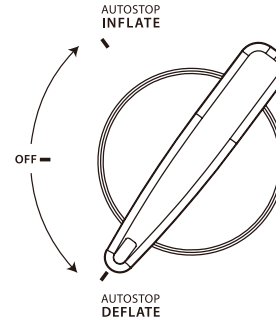
8. If the REST AIRE® requires adjustment, repeat step 7.
9. Your REST AIRE® is now ready to use. Make up bed as desired with sheets and bedding.

TO DEFLATE AND STORE

1. Plug pump into a grounded 120 volt AC electrical outlet.
2. Valve must be closed for the Auto Stop function to work.



3. Deflate mattress by turning knob from OFF position to DEFLATE position. Once fully deflated, pump will automatically stop.
4. Release the valve. The REST AIRE® mattress is now ready for storage. Roll and place the mattress in the convenient duffel bag.

LIMITED 3 YEAR WARRANTY

REST AIRE® warrants to the original purchaser only when the REST AIRE® is used for normal indoor temporary sleeping purposes, that the mattress will be fully guaranteed against defects in material and workmanship for a period of 3 months from the date of purchase, provided further that the REST AIRE® has been operated and cared for according to the provided instructions and uses. Warranty does not cover punctures caused by misuse.

If defect occurs in months 4 - 12 from the original purchase date the manufacturer will offer a credit of 50% of the current manufacturer's Suggested Retail Price for the mattress. This credit is to be applied towards the purchase of a replacement REST AIRE® mattress directly from the original manufacturer. Shipping and handling charges to ship the replacement mattress are the responsibility of the consumer.

The pump is guaranteed to the original purchaser against defects in materials and workmanship for a period of 36 months from the date of original purchase provided that the pump has been operated according to the provided instructions. If defect in the pump occur in months 4 - 36 from the original purchase date, the manufacturer will offer a credit of 50% of the current manufacturer's Suggested Retail Price. This credit is to be applied towards the purchase of a replacement mattress directly from the original manufacturer. Shipping and handling charges to ship the replacement are the responsibility of the consumer.

Our obligation under this warranty shall be limited to the repair or exchange of any part which may prove defective under the conditions and during the periods described above.

This warranty shall not apply if upon inspection we find:

1. Any product or part has been damaged by alteration.
2. Any product or part has been subject to accident, misuse, abuse or has been operated contrary to the provided instructions or uses.

To submit a request for warranty replacement go to www.expressbedshelp.com and follow the detailed instructions on how to process a warranty claim. A copy of the Original Receipt is required as proof of purchase that validates the warranty.

This is the entire exclusive express limited warranty. The manufacturer neither makes nor is responsible for any other warranties, either expressed or implied, including those of retailing dealers. Any and all liability for breach of warranty, as well as damages for incidental, special or consequential losses are expressly denied.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Mattresses are constructed of heavy duty vinyl designed for optimum comfort when used at normal household temperatures.

WARNING:

*Avoid extreme cold, as vinyl will become brittle. Do not overinflate.
Do not use high pressure or compressed air inflation systems.
Avoid sharp objects. Do not use hair dryer to inflate.*

WARNING: FLAMMABLE

VINYL IS FLAMMABLE. Do not locate bed near fire, fireplace or any other heat source, such as a space heater. Avoid placing bed over a heat emitting floor vent.

PVC, the material used to make air mattresses, will naturally stretch and expand during use. After being inflated for several hours and/or having been slept on, the air mattress may lose some of its initial firmness and feel softer because the PVC has naturally expanded. This expansion is normal and not the result of a leak. To regain your desired firmness level, add air to the mattress using the pump that was provided with the mattress.

Clean only with mild soap and water. Harsh cleaners can damage materials. Use repair kit to patch any holes, tears or punctures. Store at room temperature only AFTER cleaned and dried. Do not store outdoors or in a garage.

USES

Use the REST AIRE® any time an extra temporary sleep surface is needed. The REST AIRE® is intended for normal indoor use only. The REST AIRE® is not intended to be used in place of your present everyday sleep surface.

! WARNING

Risk of Suffocation

- Infants have suffocated on inflatable mattresses. Never place an infant 15 months and younger to sleep on an inflatable mattress.
- When used by children over 15 months old:
 - Provide at least a shoulder width space between mattress and walls, dressers or other vertical objects to avoid entrapment.
 - Always keep mattress fully inflated when in use.
