AWARNING

- Unit must be placed on a level surface or leveled with included hardware (when applicable).
- Do not sit or stand on or allow children to climb, sit or stand on the assembled product.
- For safety reasons, it is imperative that this unit be mounted on the wall or floor.
- Do not use without installing the tip restraint.
- Unit can tip over causing severe injury or death
- Never open more than one drawer at a time.

- Before cutting, drilling or hammering into any wall or floor surface, verify the location of electrical, plumbing and gas lines. Cutting may cause serious injury.




PLANNING ASSEMBLY




Disassembly












Back panel assembly Dowel preparation






Attaching the right back





7 Attaching the handle and hinge adjustment


Door hinge adjustment instructions

B. Up and down adjustment by adjusting mounting plate slot.


C. Side to side adjustment by clockwise or anticlockwise adjustment.

8 Fixing to wall


- Drill a hole and insert Wall pulg.

Safety notice

The consumer product safety commission recommends anchoring furniture in homes where children live or visit. In order to protect you and your family the manufacturer of this product has included an easy to install safety device. To hide the bracket behind the unit, drill the hole lower than the top of unit.

Warning: Always ensure intended wall area to be drilled is free from hidden electrical wires, water, and gas pipes.



Troubleshooting

Problems	Solutions
Drawer cannot be attached to product	Check if drawer two side boards slides are assembled backwards.
Drawer can not pull in or pull out smoothly	Check drawer attched frame silde bearing pull outside before assembly. Please refer to drawer assembly section.
Drawer cannot be removed	When removing the drawer, tip-up the safety release tab to remove the drawer from the body.
Door cannot be closed / not flat	Adjust the euro hinge make sure it is assembled on appropriate position.
Not all leg touch the ground	Make sure adjustable center feet levelers are adjusted properly. The levelers are pre assembled on the bottom of the legs.
Panel cannot be assembed	Make sure panel is on right direction. Refer to IM details.

Maintenance

- Keep the product away from direct heat and sunlight.
- Prolonged exposure to heat sources may cause scorching, or even cause color to fade .
- Regular vacuuming or light brushing helps to remove dirt and prevent soil build-up, which increases the appearance of wear.
- $^{ ext{ o}}$ Periodically (every 90 days) make sure that the screws are fully tightened .

Care and Cleaning

- Handle with care.
- Use a slightly damp cloth to clean the product. Do not use bleach or use abrasive cleaning material.
- Check all the fittings periodically and re-tighten as necessary. Do not us the product if any of the parts are damaged or broken.
- □ Never allow any kind of liquid to remain on your furniture .
- Absorption can make wood wrap or delaminate .
- □ Do not place hot items (e.g. hot drinks) directly onto the wood surface.
- Do not drag and /or pull the furniture .
- □ Never use harsh chemicals or solvents on your product as this may damage the metal .
- Marks and stains from pens, crayons and ink markers are difficult to remove. In the event that your products become permanently stained, we recommend that you consult a professional.
