

1 Cover Vents/Openings

Cover sink vents or openings with a wet rag.

Common examples include:

Dishwasher vent



Sink overflow opening



Double sink



2 Add Water

Ensure there is enough water in the sink to cover the base of the plunger.



3 Plunge

Angle plunger into the sink, letting the head fill with water as you completely cover the drain.



Pulse plunger in even up-and-down motion for 10-15 seconds, then break the seal.



Repeat this process until the water drains/clog is cleared.

4 Clear Debris

Once the clog is cleared, run hot water to clear out any leftover debris and help prevent future clogs.
