INSTRUCTIONS

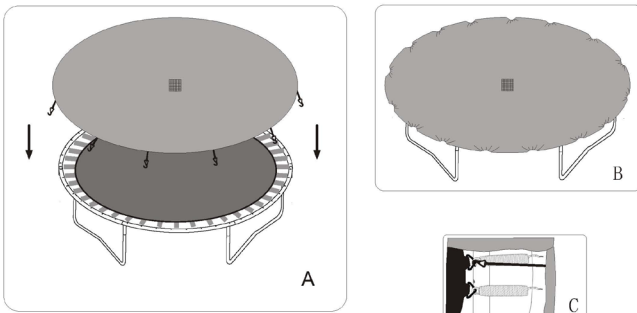
Unfold the Trampoline Cover and lay it on the ground next to the trampoline. Make sure that the elastic bands are located on the underside of the cover. If possible, it is suggested that 2 or more people install this Trampoline Cover.

A. Lay the flattened cover on top of the trampoline mat, with the elastic bands facing down. Make sure that it is covering both the frame pad and top rail.

B. Pull each band around the outer edge of the top rail and pull so the band is under the trampoline mat.

C. Attach each band to a V-Ring on the mat (as shown in Figure C) ensuring that the band is fully taut so that the trampoline cover remains snug.

NEVER JUMP ON, CLIMB ONTO OR STAND ON THE TRAMPOLINE WHILE THE TRAMPOLINE COVER IS STILL ATTACHED.

Storing Your Trampoline Off Season

1. Examine your trampoline thoroughly. Look for damaged or rusted springs, frayed areas on the pad, and bent or twisted frame pieces. If found, cease using trampoline and call customer service to obtain replacement part(s).
2. Brush off the trampoline mat, and ensure frame pad is securely attached.
3. Securely attach this cover.
4. Attach Pure Fun Anchor Kit (sold separately).

Note: if you live in an area which experiences strong winds, a cover and/or anchor kit may not provide sufficient protection. In this situation, Pure Fun recommends you disassemble your trampoline and safely store it to prevent damage to the trampoline, persons, and/or property, for which Pure Fun is not liable.

!WARNING!

Never jump on a trampoline while the cover is still attached. Failure to fully remove the cover before trampoline use can result in serious injury or death.

Never allow children to play with or on this trampoline cover, either when attached or unattached to the trampoline.

Do not use this product in any manner inconsistent with its intended use.

When removing the trampoline cover, secure it in a safe, dry location inaccessible by small children.

To avoid danger of suffocation, keep this cover away from babies and small children. Do not use this cover in play areas, play pens, cribs, beds, or carriages.
