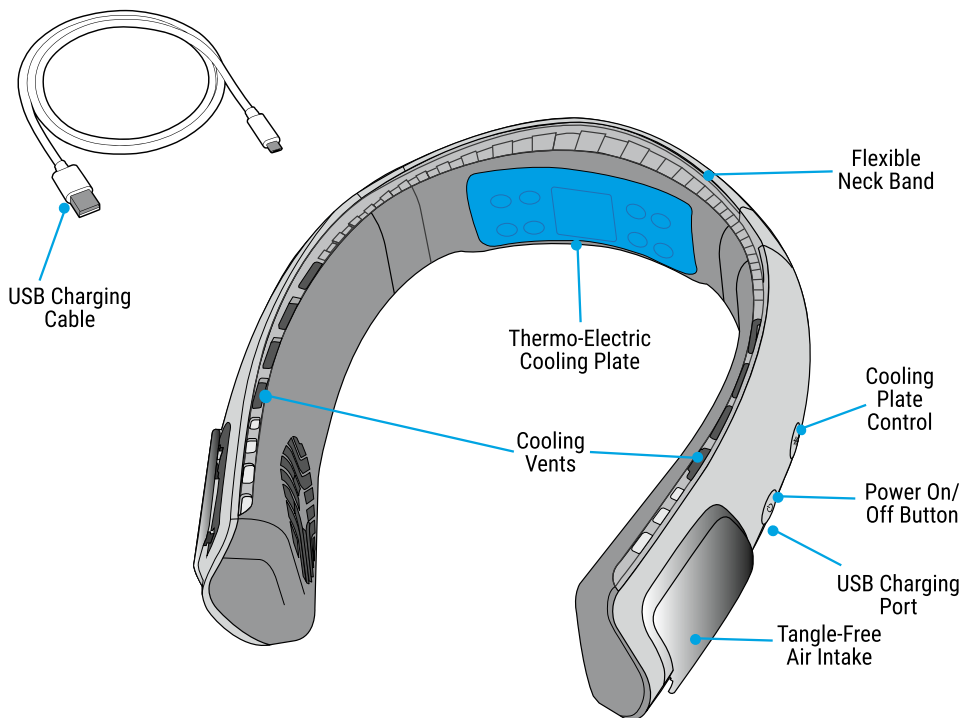

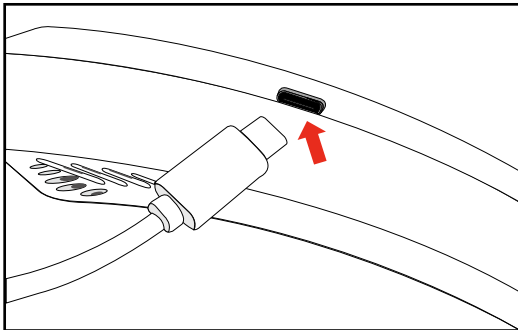


CHARGING THE BATTERY:

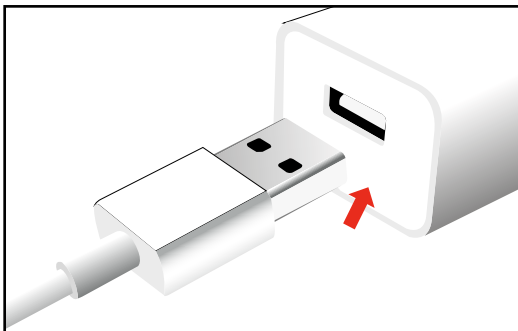
Arctic Air Freedom® Touch comes partially charged – For Best Results, fully charge battery before first use.

NOTE: When fully charged, you can expect runtime of 3-6 hours depending on fan speed.

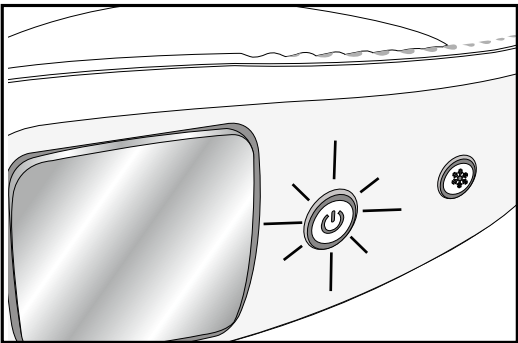
1. Using included USB cable, plug small end into charging port located on side of unit.



2. Plug large end of USB cable into a USB-Power adapter, laptop, or other device (not included).

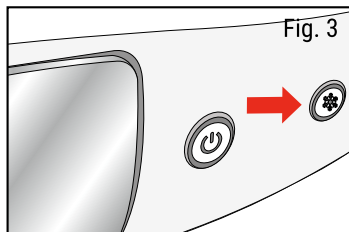
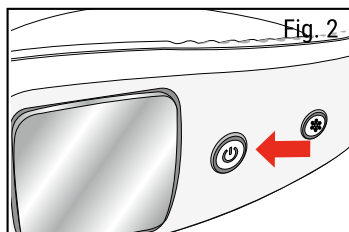
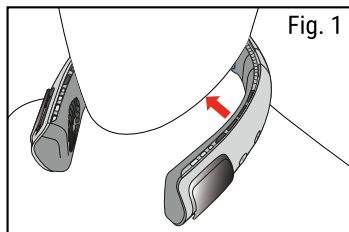


3. Power Button will begin blinking to indicate unit is charging. When light remains solid, Arctic Air Freedom® Touch is fully charged.



USE:

1. Place Arctic Air Freedom® Touch around your neck, with Air Vents facing up towards your face. See Fig.1
2. Press the power button located on the side to turn on – light will glow to indicate unit has power.
NOTE: Fan speed will default to HIGH. Press button again to change to MEDIUM, and again to change to LOW. See Fig. 2
3. Cooling plate will default to on. If you would like to extend runtime of the fans, or use without cooling plate, press the Cooling Plate Control to turn off. See Fig. 3
4. When done, press power button until unit turns off. Store in a cool, dry location until next use.
