Assembly



CAUTION: Assemble on a flat surface. Make sure the surface is free of debris or the cabinet is protected. A piece of cardboard is recommended to keep the product from being scratched during assembly.




CAUTION: Please wear gloves during the whole assembling process to avoid accidental personal injury.



CAUTION: For component with protective film, please peel off the protective film before assembling it.


1 ATTACH THE SIDE AND BOTTOM PANELS

Attach the side panels (B & H) and bottom panel (G) together.




2 INSTALL THE ADJUSTABLE FEET

- □ Install the adjustable feet (DD) to the bottom panel (G). Make sure side A of the adjustable feet (DD) are facing towards the outside of the cabinet. Tighten securely with sixteen M6 x 16 hex socket head screws (AA).
- □ Fix the side panels (B & H) and the bottom panel (G) with two M6 x 16 hex socket head screws (AA). Tighten securely.




3 ATTACH THE TOP PANEL

Attach the top panel (A) to the side panels (B & H) with four M6 x 16 hex socket head screws (AA). Tighten securely.



4 ATTACH THE BACK PANELS

- □ Lay the cabinet on its face.
- □ Attach the back panels (J) to the back of the cabinet with twelve M6 x 16 hex socket head screws (AA). Insert the screws by hand. D0 NOT tighten.
- □ Fix the side panels (B & H) and bottom panel (G) together with two M6 x 16 hex socket head screws (AA). Insert the screws by hand. DO NOT tighten.




5 FIX THE TOP PANEL, BOTTOM PANEL AND SIDE PANELS




CAUTION: Two M6 x 16 hex socket head cap screws (FF) (security screws) should be fixed to the left bottom face of cabinet for additional door security.

Fix the top panel, bottom panel and side panels with six
 M6 x 16 hex socket head screws (AA) and two M6 x 16
 hex socket head cap screws (FF). Insert the screws by hand.
 D0 N0T tighten.




6 INSTALL THE CLOSET ROD STEP 6-1

- Insert the two tabs of a closet rod mounting bracket's (I) inner end into the mounting slots at the inner back side of the left side panel.
- □ Fix the outer end of the closet rod mounting bracket (I) to the side panel front with one M6 x 16 hex socket head screw (AA).



STEP 6-2


Insert the closet rod (D) into the mounting hole of the other closet rod mounting bracket (I).



6 INSTALL THE CLOSET ROD (CONTINUED)


STEP 6-3

Insert the left end of the closet rod (D) into the mounting hole of the closet rod mounting bracket (I) already fixed to the left side panel.




STEP 6-4

Follow the same procedure of step 6-1 to install the other closet rod mounting bracket (I) to the right side panel.




7 INSTALL THE SHELVES

- Insert eight shelf brackets (CC) into the slots on the side panels at the desired height. Make sure the four brackets (CC) for each shelf (E) are at the same height.
- Place the shelves (E) over the shelf brackets (CC), and push them down onto the shelf brackets.
- Make sure the shelves (E) are properly and safely locked by the upright hooks of the shelf brackets.




8 ATTACH THE DOORS

- Insert the pins of the hinges on the left door (C) into the slots of the bottom hinges at the front of the left side panel (B).
- Repeat the same procedure to attach the right door (F).
- Close the doors to see if the doors can touch the magnets completely. If not, adjust the cabinet's top and side panels to make sure the shape of the cabinet is square and flush.
 Until the doors can catch the magnets completely and are flush, tighten all the screws at the cabinet front and back.



9 INSTALL THE GROMMETS

- Insert the short side of the hex wrench by half into your desired cord access holes, and pry the knock-outs towards your side.
- □ Take away the knock-outs carefully and install the grommets (GG).



10 CONNECT THE CABINET TO THE WALL





CAUTION: The M6 x 40 hex tapping bolts (BB) should be drilled into the stud of the wall.



CAUTION: The safety bracket's bottom M6 x 40 hex tapping bolt should be 70.4 in. from the floor.

- □ Install the safety bracket (EE) to the wall with two M6 x 40 hex tapping bolts (BB).
- Fasten the tall cabinet by using the safety strap (L) to tie the tall cabinet and safety bracket (EE) together. Tighten securely.

View from cabinet top


Maintenance

- □ Check all the screws and nuts periodically for tightness. Tighten them when necessary.
- Check the safety strap periodically for tightness. Tighten it when necessary.

Care and Cleaning

- $\hfill \square$ Periodically clean the surfaces with a soft rag and water.
- Grease and oil can be removed with most standard cleaning fluids. For safety, use a nonflammable cleaning fluid.
