Visit the **EPA List N** online to compare the label # with the registration # on List N.

Check the product's label for its EPA registration number - the first two sets of numbers after the phrase EPA Reg. No., usually on the back towards the bottom.

Products may be marketed under different brands, but if they have the same first two sets of EPA numbers, they are related.

**12345-67

12345-67-890
are related**

If EPA Reg. No. 12345-67 is on List N, you can buy EPA Reg. No. 12345-67-890 and use the same contact time and virus from List N.
