

Use and Care Manual

Installation: Assemble the poles via threaded connections and adjust the height freely with multiple middle sections, offering an overall adjustable range of 12 to 15 feet. For ground installation, drive the stake fully into the soil. Soften hard soil with water beforehand if needed. It can also be securely mounted on fences or patio posts using clips and screws to enhance wind resistance and stability.

Usage: Only for hanging lightweight outdoor decorations such as string lights, lanterns and flags. Never overload with heavy items or pull forcefully, to avoid pole deformation and tipping over.

Cleaning: Wipe dust and water stains from the pole with a soft dry cloth for daily maintenance. Do not use strong acidic or alkaline cleaners or hard brushes, which may damage the anti-rust coating. Avoid scratches and impacts from sharp objects to protect the surface finish.

Inspection: For long-term outdoor use, regularly check all spliced joints, ground stakes, clips and screws for looseness, and tighten them in a timely manner.

Storage: After disassembly when not in use, clean thoroughly and store in a dry, ventilated area to prevent moisture and corrosion, extending the service life of the metal poles.
