Assembly


Attaching the posts to the panels

 \Box Align four posts (AA) with pre-drilled holes on each of the panels and frame (A – C) and secure with four screws (BB) on each panel and frame (A – C).



2 Attaching the side panels into the face frame

□ Start by placing the face frame (C) flat on a smooth surface that will not scratch or damage the face of the cabinet, such as a towel or piece of cardboard (1) from the packaging with the door facing down. Slide the two side panels (B) into the mating grooves on the face frame (C).




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
3 Attaching the top and bottom panels

- □ Slide top and bottom panels (D) into the grooves of the assembly.
- □ Snap four corner locks (CC) over the posts to secure the assembly, as shown. The remaining four corner locks (CC) are installed in the next step.




4 Attaching the back panel

□ Install the back panel (A) and attach the four remaining corner locks (CC), as shown.



5 Securing the corner locks

□ Insert a screw (BB) through the hole in each of the eight corner locks (CC), and screw into the top/bottom panels.




6 Securing the back and side panels in place

□ Insert screws (BB) into countersunk holes in the back (A) and side panels (B).




NOTE: Wall cabinets 27 in. and wider will have four holes through the back, all other sizes will have two.




7 Attaching silicone pads

 Peel and stick two silicone pads (EE) onto the inside corners of each door.



8 (OPTIONAL) Reversing the door position

 You can remove and reposition the door to the other side of the face frame at any time using the pre-drilled holes.
For pre-drilled holes that are not used, you can cover them up using a wax pencil or touch-up paint pen.




9 (OPTIONAL) Adjusting the door

- Door hinges are 6-way adjustable.
- □ Up or down adjustment Loosen screw 1, align the door, and tighten screw 1.



NOTE: It is critical that you do NOT overtighten screw 1.

- Left or right adjustment Turn screw 2 clockwise or counterclockwise.
- In or out adjustment Turn screw 3 clockwise or counterclockwise.




10 Installing the shelves

- Place the shelf pins (DD) inside the assembly at the desired locations using the pre-drilled holes.
- Tilt the shelves (E) to fit inside the face frame and snap over the shelf pins (DD).
- To remove the shelves, push the tabs (1) on the shelf pins and lift the shelf.



NOTE: Do not install shelves until the cabinet assembly has been fully installed.



Care and Cleaning

- For normal spills, a damp cloth is sufficient. Dry the surface immediately.
- Doors can be cleaned with most general purpose household cleaners.
- □ Do not use caustic agents and/or abrasive scrubbers, or oven cleaners.
- Cabinets can be cleaned with a damp sponge or cloth using soapy water, or most general purpose household cleaners. Do not use any abrasive cleaner or scrubbers.
- Do not allow liquids to remain on the surfaces for long periods of time.
