PLANT CARE Cacti & Succulents

Light

I like bright, indirect light where I cast a strong shadow at least a couple of hours a day.

Water

I don't want my roots to stay wet, so let the potting soil dry before you water me again.

Food

I don't need a lot of fertilizer, so you can feed me once or twice in spring and/or summer. You can feed me more often if you want me to grow faster.

Features

Cacti and succulents come in a diverse range of colors, textures, and sizes -- all with low water needs!

Growing tips

Take care not to overwater us; we need to be more dry than wet. Cacti & succulents are perfect for DIY projects!

Aloe Vera, Echeveria, Jade Plant
