The Old Farmer's Almanac Fertilizer Spikes provide essential nutrients trees and shrubs need to grow and thrive. Just hammer spikes into the soil, under your plant's drip line, and they'll feed your plants all season long without dust, breakage or runoff.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For best results apply in early spring & late fall.

Water well before application.

Using a hammer, drive each spike into the soil until the top is 2 inches below the surface.

Evenly space spikes in a circle along the dripline.

Never insert spikes closer than 30 inches from the trunk.

For shrubs 1 spike per 3 feet of plant height is recommended.

For trees measure the trunk diameter 1 foot above the ground; and use 1 spike per inch of diameter with a minimum of 2 spikes.

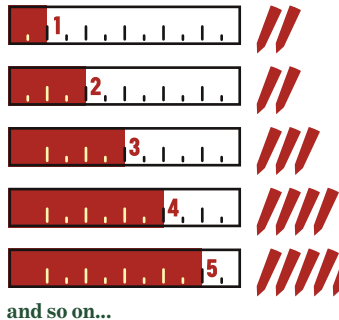

FOR BEAUTIFUL TREES

Measure trunk diameter (width) 1 foot above the ground. Use 1 spike per measured inch with a minimum of 2 spikes.

CONSEJOS DE PRUDENCIA

Para mejores resultados, aplique a principios de la primavera y finales del otoño. Riegue bien antes de la aplicación. Usando un martillo, inserte cada espiga en el suelo hasta que la parte superior esté al menos 2 pulgadas debajo de la superficie. Espacia de manera uniforme los picos en un círculo a lo largo de la línea de goteo. Nunca inserte más de 30 pulgadas del tronco.
Para los arbustos, use 1 espiga por cada 3 pies de altura de la planta. Para los árboles, mida el diámetro del tronco a un pie del suelo y use 1 espiga por pulgada de diámetro con un mínimo de 2 espigas.

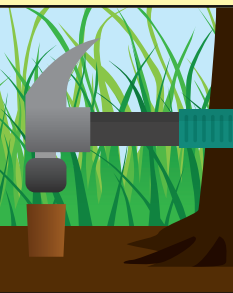

FOR BEAUTIFUL SHRUBS

Measure the shrub height, evenly spaced 3 feet of shrub height, evenly spaced along the dripline.

WHAT IS THE DRIPLINE?

The dripline lies along the outermost circumference of a tree's branches. (See diagram on this package.)

Spikes should be evenly spaced in a circle along the dripline. For small trees and shrubs, with a dripline closer to the trunk than 30 inches, insert spikes

30 inches away from the center and at least 3 feet apart.
