





- TIGHTEN ALL THE SCREWS EVERY 6 MONTHS.
- DO NOT SHIFT OR DRAG THE PRODUCT AFTER ASSEMBLY.
- THE FOLLOWING TOOLS ARE NOT INCLUDED.



CLEANING AND CARE

- CLEAN SURFACES WITH A DRY OR DAMP CLOTH.
- DO NOT USE ABRASIVE CLEANERS.
- DO NOT USE FURNITURE WAX OR POLISH AS THE UNIT IS FINISHED WITH A PROTECTIVE CLEAR LACQUER.


REPLACEMENT PARTS

NOTE: Many of the boards are similar in appearance. Pay close attention to the differences between the boards as well as to the placement of the bolts.


Step 1:

Start assembling by fixing the Dowels (C) to Side Panel Left (1), Side Panel Right (2), Shelf Panel (5) Center Panel Top (6) and Center Panel Bottom (7).




Step 2:

Using a phillips head screwdriver, fix the Minifix Bolts (A) to Side Panel Left (1), Side Panel Right (2), Top Panel (3) and Shelf Panel (5).




Step 3:

Use two CSK Screws (D) to attach the Shelf Panel (5) and Center Panel Top (6). Make sure that the grooves for the Back Panel are aligned and that the bolts are facing away from the shelf panel as in the drawing. (The grooves referred to are on the sides not shown in the drawing below).




Step 4:

Insert the Minifix Cams (B) into the Center Panel Bottom (7). Attach the Center Panel Bottom (7) to the Shelf Panel (5). While doing this make sure that the grooves for the Back Panel are aligned. Tighten the two Minifix Cams (B) clockwise and then cover them with Cam Caps (E).




Step 5:

Insert the Minifix Cams (B) into the Shelf Panel (5). Attach Side Panel Left (1) to the Shelf Panel (5). While doing this make sure that the grooves for the Back Panel are aligned. Tighten the two Minifix Cams (B) clockwise and cover them with Cam Caps (E).




Step 6:

Insert the Minifix Cams (B) into the Shelf Panel (5). Attach Side Panel Right (2) to the Shelf Panel (5). While doing this make sure that the grooves for the Back Panel are aligned. Tighten the two Minifix Cams (B) clockwise and cover them with Cam Caps (E).




Step 7:

Slide in one Back Panel (8) with the finished side facing inside the cube. Note that the back panels are not square. The short side should meet with the groove of the Shelf Panel (5).




Step 8:

Use six CSK Screws (D) to attach the Bottom Panel (4) to Side Panel Left (1), Side Panel Right (2) and Center Panel Bottom (7). You may need to push on the back panel to align it with the groove in the bottom panel.




Step 9:

Slide in the other Back Panel (8) with the finished side facing inside the cube. Note the orientation of the short and long sides in the drawing.



Step 10:

Insert the Minifix Cams (B) into the Side Panel Left (1), Side Panel Right (2) and Center Panel Top (6) and attach the Top Panel (3). Tighten the six Minifix Cams (B) clockwise and cover with Cam Caps (E).



SAFETY AND MAINTENANCE

- DO NOT stand on the desk. Do not use the desk as a stepladder.
- DO NOT use the desk unless all bolts and screws are firmly secured.
- Every 6 months, check all bolts and screws to ensure they are tight.
