General Tips

- Assemble furniture on a soft, clean surface to avoid scratches.
 - Use only the tools and hardware provided in the assembly instructions.
 - Keep products in climate-controlled indoor environments.
 - Avoid direct sunlight and prolonged exposure to moisture or heat.
 - Check and retighten hardware periodically for stability.

Care & Cleaning Guidelines

Solid Wood, Veneer, and Painted High-Grade MDF

- Wipe regularly with a soft, dry cloth or a wood furniture cleaner.
- Use coasters to prevent heat or moisture rings.
- Clean spills immediately to prevent staining or warping.
- Avoid abrasive cleaners and excessive water.

High-Grade MDF and Laminate

- Dust frequently with a clean, dry cloth.
- For deeper cleaning, apply a small amount of furniture cleaner and immediately wipe dry.
- Avoid excess moisture, which can damage the surface.

Tempered Glass

- Use standard glass cleaner with a soft cloth or paper towel.
- Do not use abrasive sponges or pads, which may scratch the surface.

- Avoid spraying cleaner directly on metal or wood parts.

Metal

- Dust with a dry or slightly damp cloth.
- If using a damp cloth, dry the surface immediately to prevent rust or discoloration.
- Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

Faux Leather

- Wipe gently with a dry or damp cloth.
- If using leather cleaner, test on a hidden spot first to ensure compatibility.
- Avoid soaking or scrubbing the material.

Fabric Upholstery

- Spot clean with a damp cloth and mild detergent if needed.
- Address spills promptly to avoid staining.
- Do not machine wash unless the product instructions specifically allow it.

Additional Reminders

- Use furniture only as intended and within weight limits stated in the product manual.
- Avoid climbing, standing, or sitting on parts not designed for those uses.
- Keep small parts and packaging away from children.
