Peperomia

This plant needs to live in a room with at least some natural light. Place it on a table or countertop with windows nearby.



WATER This plant can only go 1-2 weeks without water so check on it weekly and add water

on it weekly and add water every time the top two inches of soil dry out.

FOOD

Feed me once or twice a year during Spring and Summer with a fertilizer formulated for houseplants.

I have lovely variegated leaves that are easy to care for.

GROWING TIPS

Avoid overwatering. Peperomia is susceptible to root rot if it stays too wet. Wipe the leaves down once or twice a month to prevent dust build up.
