




Assembly

Connecting The Seat To The Right Arm



NOTE: Loosely tighten all bolts using the hex wrench (EE).

- □ Place the right arm (C) on a soft surface.
- Connect the seat (D) to the right arm (C) using M6x30 combination bolts (BB).




2 Connecting The Seat To The Left Arm




NOTE: Loosely tighten all bolts using the hex wrench (EE).

- □ Place the left arm (B) on a soft surface.
- □ Connect the seat (D) to the left arm (B) using M6x30 combination bolts (BB).




Assembly (continued)

4 Attaching The Backrest To The Seat




Assembly (continued)

5 Tightening The Bolts



NOTE: Loosely tighten all bolts using the hex wrench (EE).

- Once all the bolts are in place, fully tighten the bolts.
- Turn the chaise right side up.
- □ Place the seat cushion (H) and back cushion (G) on the chaise lounge.
- Ensure that all connections are secure before use.



Care and Cleaning

- □ For best results, clean the frame and fabric with a damp cloth and dry thoroughly. This will help prevent mildew by removing dirt particles that may accumulate.
- □ Do not clean with abrasive materials, bleach or solvents.
- □ Store the chaise in a dry sheltered place when not in use.
- □ Keep the chaise away from fire, extreme heat, freezing conditions, and inclement weather such as rain, hail, sleet, snow, or wind.
