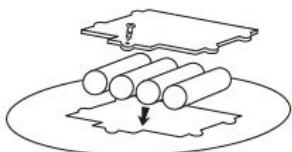


Instruction

BATTERY OPERATED WITH ELECTRIC OPTION

INSTALL BATTERIES



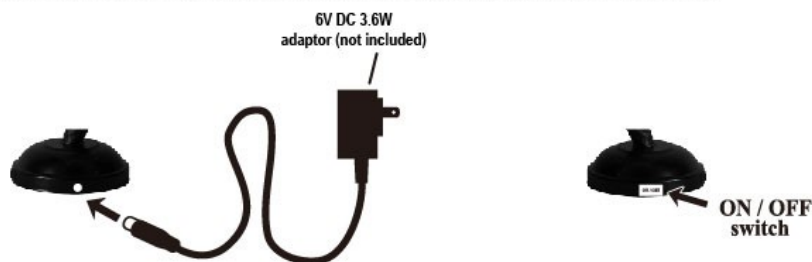
1. Need a screw driver to install. 4 AA batteries will provide you with a beautiful table light.
2. Take the product out of the box.
3. Pull off the battery compartment cover with cross screwdriver and insert 4 "AA" alkaline batteries (not included) into the battery compartment.

INSTALL ELECTRIC ADAPTOR

1. Remove rubber cap from the adaptor plug on the base of the tree.
2. Connect 6VDC 3.6W adaptor (not included).

USE

1. Press the ON / OFF on the base of the tree to operate the lights.
2. Available to DIY the branch shape according to your own demand.



IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Please read and follow all instructions and warnings both on the instructions and on the product carefully before use.

3. This product is to be used only as intended its use.
4. For indoor/ outdoor use.
5. Do not mount or place near gas or electric heaters, fireplaces, candles or other similar sources of heat.
6. Do not secure the wiring of this product with staples or nails, or place on sharp hooks, nails or in a manner that can cut or damage the wire or insulation.
7. This is an electric product and not a toy! To avoid risk of fire, burns, personal injury and electric shock it should not be played with or placed where small children can reach it.
8. Do not close doors or windows on the product or extension cords as this may damage the wire and insulation.

BATTERY WARNING:

- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) and rechargeable batteries (Nickel Metal Hydride).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the item before being charged (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision (if removable).
- Exhausted batteries should be removed immediately and must be recycled or disposed of properly according to state or local government ordinances and regulations.
- The battery supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity.
- Do not dispose batteries in a fire - batteries may leak or explode.
