
Assembly

Attaching the brackets

□ Attach the upper bracket (B) onto the lower bracket (A).




NOTE: This umbrella should be set up in its desired location to avoid moving it after assembly



2 Attaching the pedal to the turn plate


Attach the pedal (G) to the turn plate (H) using M6x10 bolt (AA) and the M6 hex wrench (FF).






$\mathbf{3}$ Pull out the lower umbrella pole from the base tube

□ Pull out the lower umbrella pole (D) from the base tube (C).




4 Attaching the turn plate to the brackets

- Attach the turn plate (H) to the brackets (A & B) using M10x25 combination bolts (DD) and the M10 hex wrench (EE).
- Attach the base tube (C) to the turn plate (H) using M10x22 combination bolts (CC) and the M10 hex wrench (EE).




5 Pouring sand and water into the bases

- Open the side bases (I) and the middle bases (J) in the counterclockwise direction.
- $\hfill\square$ Pour sand and water into the side bases (I) and the middle bases (J).
- □ Close the side bases (I) and the middle bases (J) in the clockwise direction.




6 Attaching the middle bases to the brackets

□ Attach the middle bases (J) onto the brackets (A & B).




7 Attaching the side bases to the brackets

□ Attach the side bases (I) to the bracket (A & B).




${f 8}$ Inserting the middle umbrella pole into the base tube

- □ Insert the lower base cover (L) into the base tube (C).
- □ Insert the upper base cover (K) into the base tube (C).
- □ Insert the lower umbrella pole (D) into the base tube (C).




${f g}$ Connecting the umbrella shade into the base tube

Connect the umbrella shade (F) into the base tube (C) using one M6x15 bolt (BB) and M6 hex wrench (FF).



10 Attaching the crank to the umbrella shade


□ Attach the crank (E) to the umbrella shade (F).



Operation


Opening the umbrella

- □ Shake the umbrella fabric before opening the umbrella.
- Press the button on the umbrella shade (F) and slowly turn the crank (E) clockwise to open the umbrella.




2 Rotating the umbrella

□ Hold the pedal (G) with one foot and rotate the umbrella pole (The umbrella can rotate up to 360 degrees).




3 Tilting the umbrella

□ To tilt the umbrella, push the button on the top of the umbrella shade (F), and push up or push down to desired position.




4 Closing the umbrella

- □ Slowly turn the crank in a counterclockwise direction to close the umbrella.
- □ Press the button on the umbrella shade (F) and push down.



5 Tie the umbrella to the umbrella pole


□ Tie the umbrella to the umbrella pole with the Velcro belt when not in use.

Attaching and detaching the crank

- Attach the crank (E) without using the tap as shown in figure 1. To detach the crank (E), just take the crank out.
- Attach the crank (E) to the handle as shown in figure 2. Attach the crank (E) by aligning the tap with the hole on the crank (E) until it snaps into place. To detach the crank, the hex wrench (FF) is required to press the tap to take the crank (E) out.



Care and Cleaning

- For best results, clean the umbrella with damp cloth and dry thoroughly. This will help prevent mildew by removing dirt particles that may accumulate.
- Do not clean with abrasive materials, bleach, or solvents.
- □ Store the umbrella, sheltered place when not in use.
- Keep the umbrella away from fire, extreme heat, freezing conditions, and inclement weather such as rain, hail, sleet, snow, or wind.
