POWER UP



- Insert power cord into the **bottom** of your clock (required)
- 2. Pull the plastic tab in the battery compartment for the CR2032 battery to activate. Backup only.
- 3. Select your language, time and other settings

SETTINGS

- Hold the SET button to enter Setting Menu.
- Press the + or buttons to adjust the values.
- Press the SET button to confirm and move to the next item.

WAKE UP WITH LIGHT

Wake to a White Mood Light that gently increases from 2% to 99% over a 5 minute period.

Set Light Alarm:

- Hold the LIGHT ALARM 1 button for 3 seconds to enter alarm time set mode.
- Press the + or buttons to adjust hours than minutes
- Press the LIGHT ALARM 1 button to confirm

WAKE UP WITH SOUND♡

Wake to your chosen Nature Sound that increases in volume from 1 to 8 over a 5 minute period.

Set Sound Alarm:

- Hold SOUND ALARM 2 for 3 seconds to enter alarm settings.
- Press the + or buttons to adjust hours, minutes and select your Nature Sound: (Beep | Rain | Ocean | Backwoods | Thunder | River)
- Press the SOUND ALARM 2 button to confirm

SNOOZE (LIGHT OR SOUND)


- When your alarm lights or sounds, press SNOOZE/LIGHT button. SNOOZE - duration will show in date area.
- Press any button except for SNOOZE/LIGHT to exit snooze countdown.
- Press SNOOZE/LIGHT only to change backlight.

DEACTIVATE/ACTIVATE ALARM

- 1. Press the LIGHT ALARM 1 or SOUND ALARM 2 button.
- 2. Alarm time and indicator will show for 3 seconds.
- Press the LIGHT ALARM 1 button or SOUND ALARM 2 button again, to deactivate or activate correct alarm.

PLAY NATURE SOUNDS

- Press the SOUND button to listen to Nature Sound continually.
- Change volume with the + or buttons.
- Press the SELECT button to change Nature Sounds.
- Press SOUND button again to turn off Nature Sounds.



FALL ASLEEP TO NATURE SOUNDS

Set Sleep Timer

- Press the SOUND button to turn sound on.
- Press and release TIMER button to select the Sleep Timer duration in minutes (15, 30, 45, 60, 75, 90, OFF).
- When selection is made the Sleep Timer will start.
- Nature Sound will play for the designated time then shut off.
- Press the SELECT button to change Nature Sounds.
- Press SOUND button again to turn off Nature Sounds.

NAP FEATURE

- Program your Nap duration (5-120 minutes).
- Once set, one press of the NAP button will start the countdown while you rest.

Set Nap Time:

- Hold the NAP button 3 second to enter Nap Setting.
- Use the + or button to select the nap duration.
- Press NAP button again to confirm your selection and start the countdown.
- When Nap countdown reaches zero, the alarm will sound.
- Press any button to exit nap countdown.

MOOD LIGHT INTENSITY AND COLOR

- Press MOOD LIGHT button to select mood light brightness.
 LIGHT and a number will show.
- When selection is made press the COLOR button to select your mood light color or cycle through all colors.

Color choices: Red, Yellow, Green, Cyan, Blue, Purple, White

BACKLIGHT INTENSITY


- Tap the SNOOZE/LIGHT button to select the intensity level of backlight (4 levels and OFF).
- 2. The word BACKLIGHT with the number will show.

USB CHARGING PORT

There is a 1 Amp USB charging port on the side of the clock.

- Connect your external device's USB charging cable (not included) to the USB charging port.
- Charging times will vary.
- USB Power Output: 1A maximum current.
- Charge 1A devices or devices that are self-regulating.

• When the low battery indicator appears, replace the CR2032 battery in your clock.
