

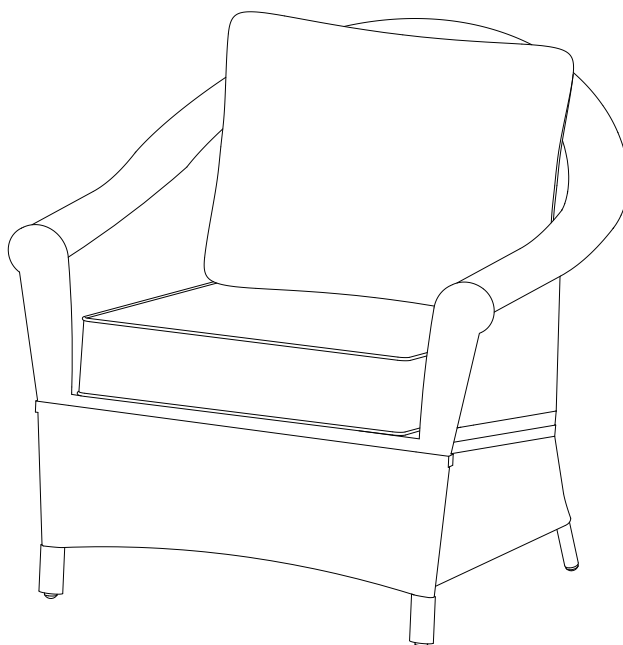

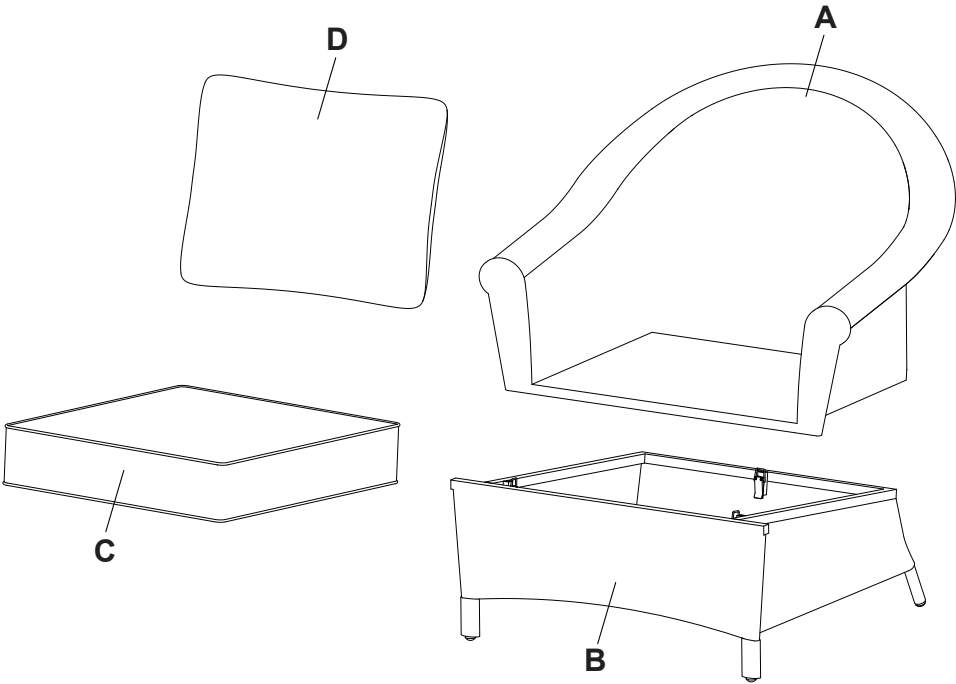

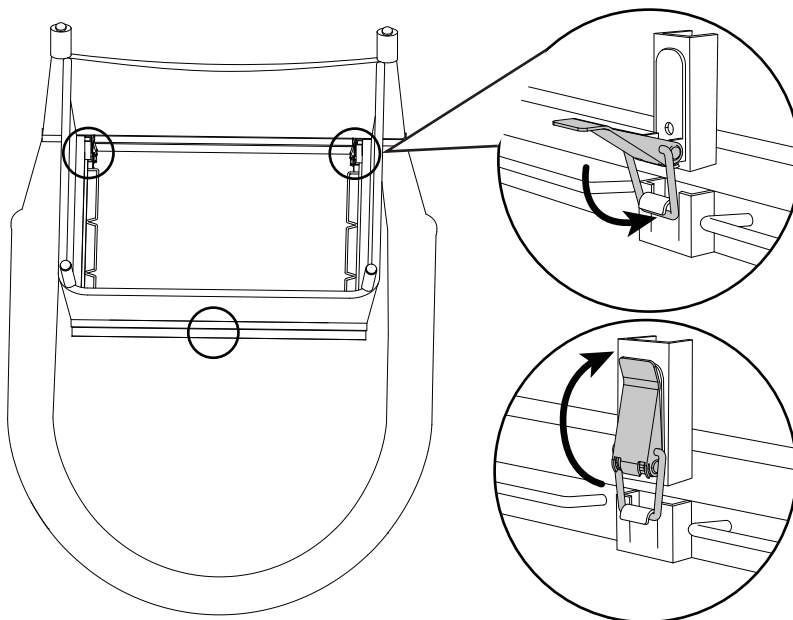

## Assembly

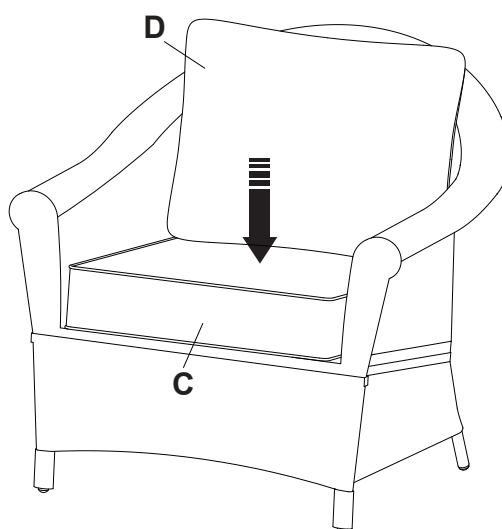
### 1 Attaching the chair base to the chair seat

- Attach the chair base (B) to the chair seat (A) by aligning the latch rings on (B) with the catches on (A). Ensure they engage, then push the levers on (B) to lock in place.



### 2 Adding the cushions.

- Add the seat cushion (C) and back cushion (D) to the chair.

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- Do not allow water to build up in the frames. This will cause corrosion and possible freezing damage in cold climates.
- Use a mild soap and water for normal cleaning. Do not use janitorial or alcohol based cleaners. Some cleaners may be marked as natural, but some ingredients may cause discoloration or have an adverse reaction to your finish.

- Treat the frames with a liquid wax for maximum protection against UV rays and/or salty, damp air.

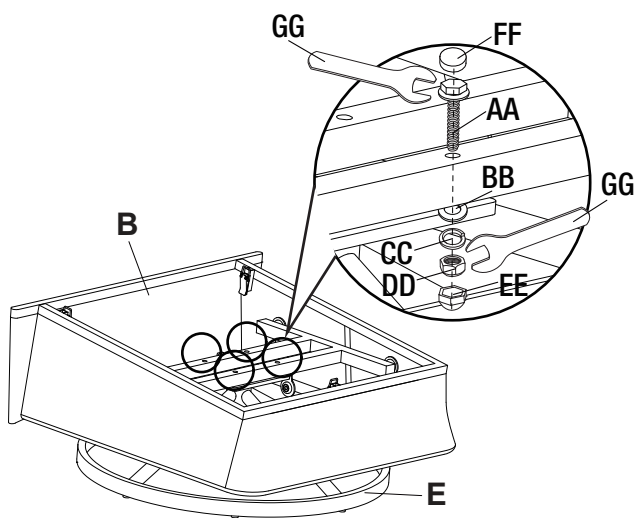
## Assembly

### 1 Attaching the chair seat to the chair base

- Attach the chair seat (B) to the chair base (E) using the M8 bolts(AA), washers (BB and CC), and nuts(DD).

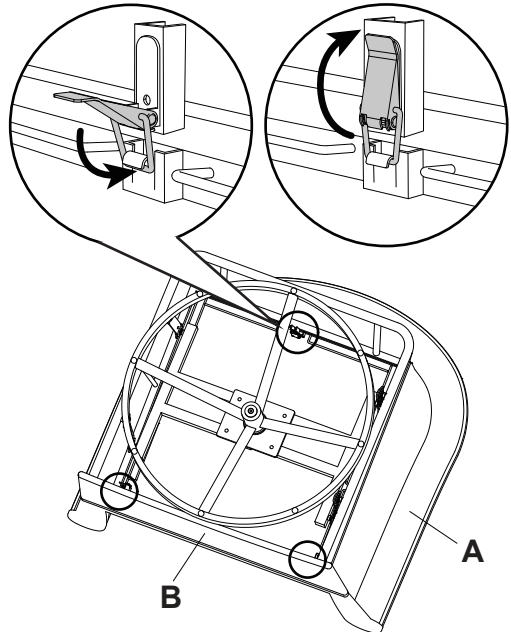


**NOTE:** Please ensure all the bolts are assembled correctly and use the hex wrench (GG) to tighten. Do not fully tighten bolts/screws until all pieces are loosely assembled. Adding corresponding plastic caps after final assembly finished.



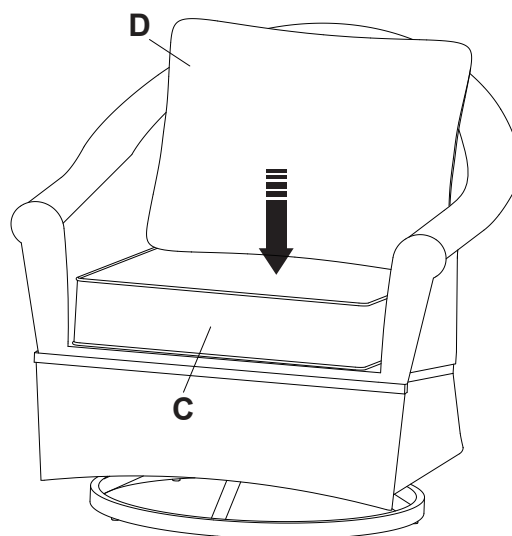
### 2 Attaching the chair seat to the chair back.

- Attach the chair seat (B) to the chair back (A) by aligning the latch rings on (B) with the catches on (A). Ensure they engage, then push the levers on (B) to lock them together.



### 3 Adding the cushions

- Add the seat cushion (C) and back cushion (D) to the chair.

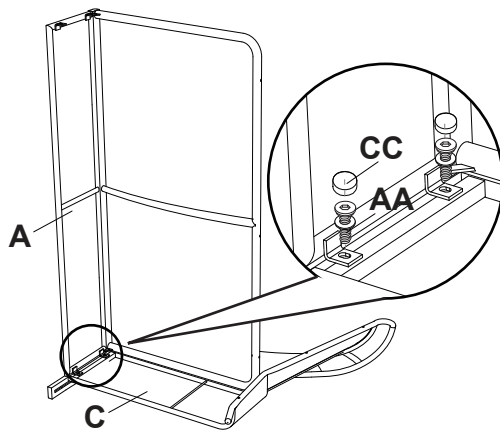
## Assembly

### 1 Attach the right arm to the loveseat seat

- Attach the right arm (C) to the loveseat seat (A) using M6 bolts (AA).



**NOTE:** Please ensure all the bolts are assembled correctly and use the allen driver (DD) to tighten. Do not fully tighten bolts/screws until all pieces are loosely assembled. Add corresponding plastic caps (CC) after final assembly finished.

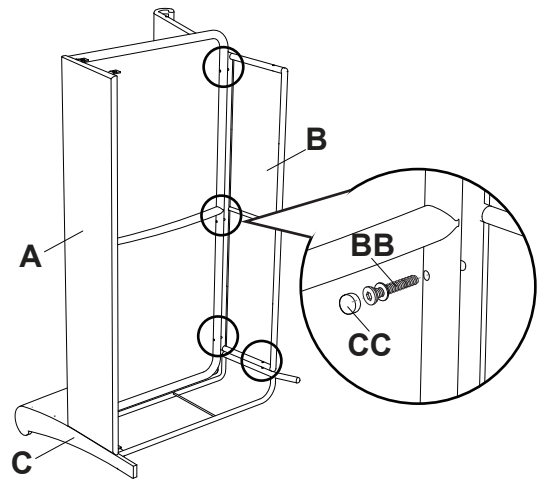


### 2 Attach the loveseat back to the loveseat seat and right arm

- Attach the loveseat back (B) to the loveseat seat (A) and right arm (C) using M6 bolts (BB).

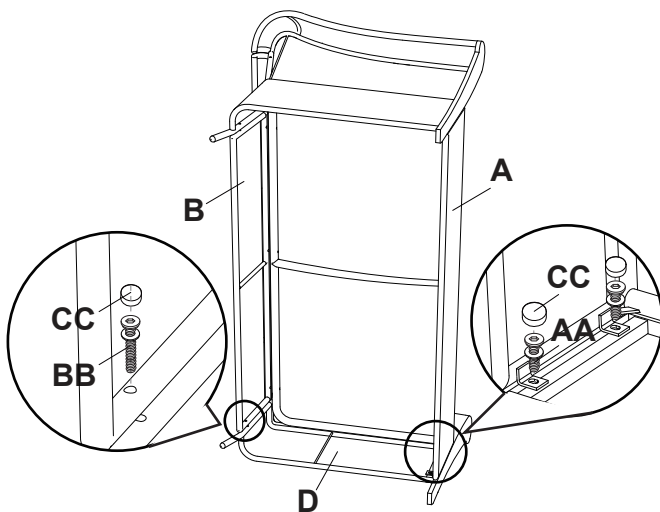


**NOTE:** Please ensure all the bolts are assembled correctly and use the allen driver (DD) to tighten. Do not fully tighten bolts/screws until all pieces are loosely assembled. Add corresponding plastic caps (CC) after final assembly finished.



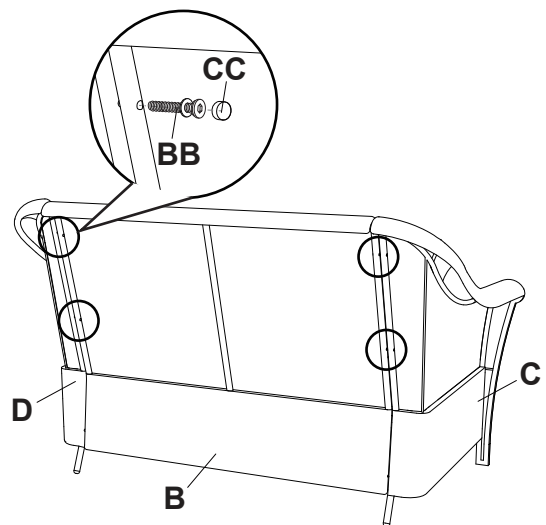
### 3 Attach the left arm to the loveseat seat and back

- Attach the left arm (D) to the loveseat seat (A) using M6 bolts (AA).  
Attach the left arm (D) to the loveseat back (B) using M6 bolts (BB).



### 4 Attach the left arm to the loveseat back

- Attach the left arm (D) to the loveseat back (B) using M6 bolts (BB).

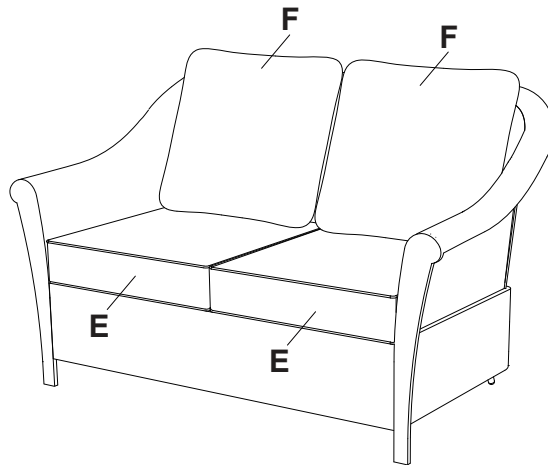

- Attach the seat cushions (E) and back cushions (F) to loveseat.

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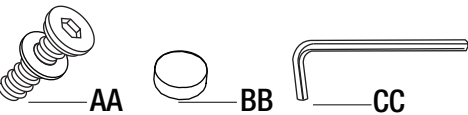

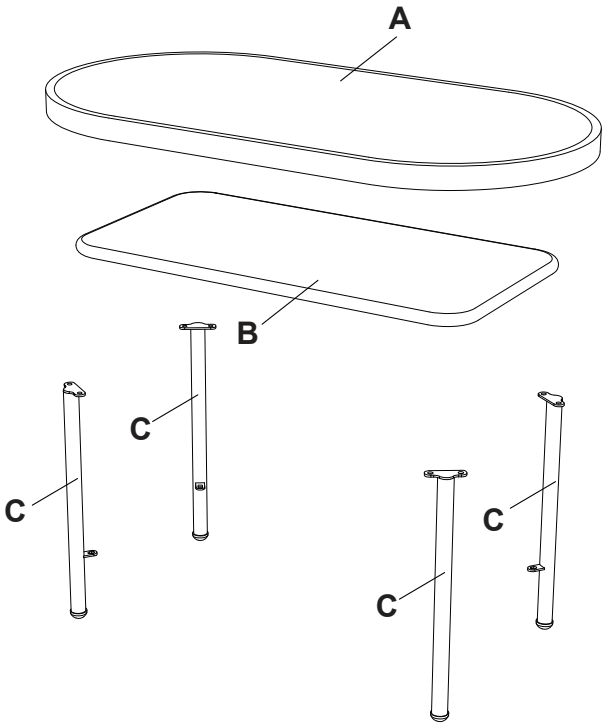

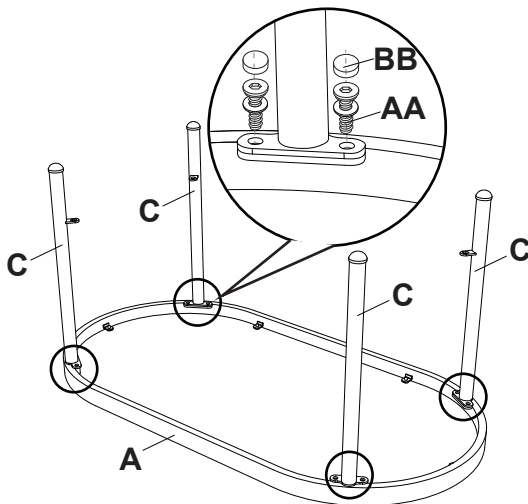
## Assembly

**NOTE:** Please ensure all the bolts are assembled correctly and use the allen driver (CC) to tighten. Do not fully tighten bolts/screws until all pieces are loosely assembled. Add corresponding plastic caps (BB) after final assembly finished.

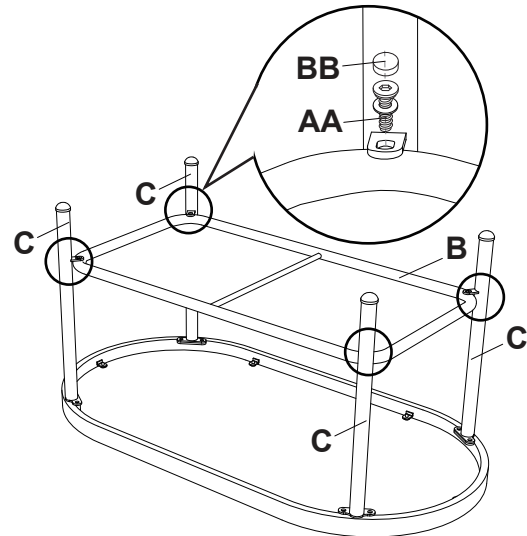


### 2 Attach the support rim to the table legs

- Attach the support rim (B) to the table legs (C) using M6 bolts (AA).

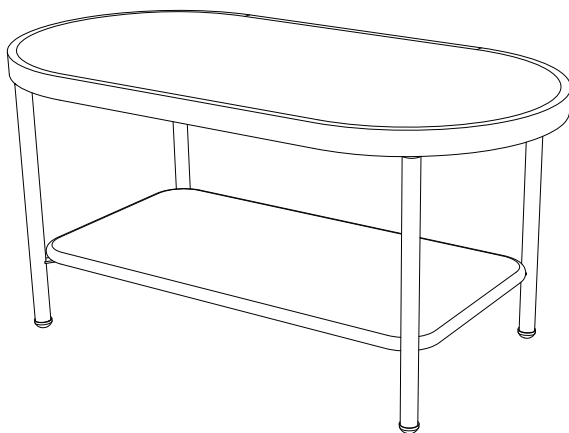
