

WASHABLE RUG – CARE & CLEANING



RECOMMENDED STEPS FOR WASHING OR CLEANING A WASHABLE RUG

- Step 1: Remove the dirty rug and put it in the wash with the design side facing out.
- Step 2: Machine wash separately using cold water, on a delicate cycle, with the design facing outwards. Use a mild, non-bleach detergent.
- Step 3: Dry on low heat, or by hang drying. Do not use fabric softener. Adding a ½ cup of white vinegar to your detergent can help neutralize pet odors.

RECOMMENDATION TO KEEP YOUR PRODUCT LOOKING NEW AND VIBRANT.

- Washer Setting: We recommend washing separately using cold water on the delicate wash cycle and a mild and non-bleach detergent.
- Dryer Setting: Set the dryer on Low Heat. Avoid high heat. It is preferred to hang the rug, so it will air dry.
 - It can take 1-2 days to air dry under normal circumstances.

For best results, you should wash the rug immediately after any major stain or accident has occurred. If you were able to wipe away the accident before it soaked into the Rug, you may spot-clean the area using a mild, non-bleach soap; however, even if you removed the accident but there is a slight odor, you should wash the Rug.

Bleach or Fabric Softeners should never be used during the washing or drying process of a washable rug.

Vacuuming is possible on our washable rug because it is lighter than a normal rug. We recommend using a low suction or low power setting, generally labeled “hard floor” or “low- pile carpet.” Always turn off the beater bar/brush before using.

Avoid vacuuming the edges and corners.

We recommend against using autonomous robot vacuums on washable rugs, as it damages the edges and corners of your rug.
