### 4. First-Aid Measures

**First Aid - Eye Contact:** Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes holding eyelids open. Get medical attention. Do NOT allow rubbing of eyes or keeping eyes closed.

First Aid - Skin Contact: Wash contaminated clothing and decontaminate footwear before reuse. Immediately flush skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes while removing clothing. Get medical attention immediately. Wash clothing separately before reuse.

# 10. Stability and Reactivity

### 11. Toxicological Information

Effects of Overexposure - Eye Contact: Causes eye burns. Irritating, and may injure eye tissue if not removed promptly. High vapor concentrations can irritate eyes, nose and respiratory passages. May cause eye irritation.

Risk of overexposure depends on duration and level of exposure to dust from repeated sanding of surfaces or spray mist and the actual concentration of Titanium Dioxide in the formula.
