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Clock Factory Restart

Explanation: The factory restart returns the clock and outdoor sensor to an "out-of-the-box" default state and often resolves an issue.

Factory Restart:

- 1. Remove all power (batteries and power cord) from the clock.
- 2. Press one of the buttons on the clock at least 20 times to clear all memory.
- 3. Verify that the clock is blank before proceeding (there may be lines painted on the screen that will show when there is no power).
- 4. Leave without power for 15 minutes (very important).
- 5. Insert the power cord into the wall outlet then into the clock.

Clock

Power Requirements

- Power cord (120-volt) as primary power source.
- A 9v battery may be added to back up time and date.

Battery Backup

- Insert one "9V" battery into the battery compartment on the bottom of the clock. The battery will keep the alarm and time settings until the power is restored.
- The LED display will not light-up but the alarm will sound at the preset alarm time.

• If there is no battery installed but the power is interrupted, the display will flash at 12:00 and the time and alarm need to be set again

Clock Dimmer

- Brighter: Slide the HI/LO display dimmer switch to HI position.
- Normal: Slide the HI/LO display dimmer switch to LO position.

Manually Set Time/Date: Program Menu

You must hold the TIME button while setting the hour and minutes.

- 1. Continuously hold down the TIME button while setting your hour and minutes.
- 2. While holding the TIME button, press the HOUR button to set your hour.

Note: The PM indicator will appear when you advance to PM time.

- 3. While holding the TIME button press the MINUTE button to set your minutes.
- 4. Release the TIME button when the correct time shows on the display.

Set Time Alarm

You must hold the ALARM button while setting the hour and minutes.

- 1. Continuously hold down the ALARM button while setting your alarm time.
- 2. While holding the ALARM button, press the HOUR button to set your alarm hour.

Note: The PM indicator will appear when you advance to PM time.

- 3. While holding the ALARM button, press the MINUTE button to set alarm minutes.
- 4. Release the ALARM button when the correct alarm time is shown on the display.

Alarm ON/OFF

- Slide the ON/OFF switch to the ON position to activate the alarm
- Slide the ON/OFF switch to the OFF position to deactivate the alarm

Snooze

- When alarm sounds, press the SNOOZE button to silence alarm for 8 minutes.
- Snooze function can be repeated many times if desired.

USB Charging Port

Note: This is a power-output charging port. It does not provide power to the alarm clock.

- Connect your external device's USB charging cable (not included) to the USB charging port.
- Charging times will vary.
- USB Power Output: 1A and 2A maximum current.
- Charge devices that are self- regulating.

Clock has missing segments

Explanation: When parts of numbers, letters, or pictures are missing on the display, it is often power related.

- Check the Power cord. Is it correctly installed and connects to an active outlet.
- Press any button 20 times. Leave the alarm clock unpowered for 1-2 hours.
- Power clock with Power cord only to determine if batteries were an issue.
