


Assembly

Attaching the table legs

- □ Place the table top (A) on a soft, flat non-abrasive surface.
- □ Attach the table legs (B) to the table top (A) with the M6 x 20 mm combination bolts (AA) using the M6 Allen wrench (CC).



NOTE: Loosely tighten all the bolts by using M6 Allen wrench (CC).




2 Attaching the leg connector

□ Attach the four legs (B) to the leg connector (C) using the M6 x 25 mm combination bolts (BB).



NOTE: Please ensure the bolts are assembled correctly and fully tighten all the bolts.



3 Positioning the table

- □ Turn the table over and set it down on its legs.
- The table is now ready for use.



Care and Cleaning

- □ Do not allow water to build up in the frames. This will cause corrosion and possible freezing damage in cold climates.
- Use a mild soap and water for normal cleaning. Do not use janitorial or alcohol based cleaners. Some cleaners may be marked as natural, but some ingredients may cause discoloration or have an adverse reaction to your finish.
- Rinse with clean water and dry with a soft, absorbent cloth towel.
- □ Treat the frames with a liquid wax for maximum protection against UV rays and/or salty, damp air.
