

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Safety Information

- 2. Two or more people are recommended for the assembly of this product.
- 3. Secure this product properly before moving it with a forklift.
- 4. Do not tow the product with power equipment.
- 5. Do not alter this product in any manner. For example, do not weld external lock bars or attach electrical equipment.
- 6. Before locking the riser cabinet, ensure the drawers are completely closed in order for the lock bars to work properly.

- 7. Extension cord
 - Follow all manufacturers' Warnings and Operating Instructions for your extension cord.
 - Do not insert extension cord through hole without grommet in place.
 - □ Only use a three-wire extension cord with all three prongs intact. Never remove the round grounding prong.
 - Extension cord must be connected to a 125 Volt GFCI protected outlet with proper ground. If GFCI outlet is not available, use an extension cord with GFCI protection built in.



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


Assembly

The 61 in. Hutch and Riser Cabinet is designed to specifically fit only on the Husky 61 in. 15-Drawer Heavy Duty Workbench Model # H61MWC15HP


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The wood top on the H61MWC15HP will be reused as the top for the 2-Drawer Riser Cabinet.






- 1. Unscrew 8 bolts from the wood top of the H61MWC15HP cabinet, but DO NOT DISCARD the bolts.
- 2. Remove the wood top.



2 Drilling holes on the wood top


- 1. Align and fix the Template (AA) on the right side of the wood top, over the two existing holes.
- 2. Use a 3/8 in. diameter drill bit to drill cleanly through the wood top.

3. Flip the Template (AA) over and repeat this procedure on the left side.




3 Attaching the riser

- 1. Place the Riser cabinet on top of the H61MWC15HP cabinet.
- 2. Using a 16mm socket or wrench, attach the Riser with 4 pcs M8×192mm long bolts (BB) in the four corners. Be careful not to over tighten.




4 Re-attach the wood top

- **1**. Position the wood top on the Riser.
- 2. Ensure the four 3/8 in. holes drilled in Step 2 align with the threaded holes in the Riser.
- 3. Attach the wood top to the riser with 8 bolts previously removed from the H61MWC15HP cabinet.




5 Attach the hutch to the riser

1. Place the Hutch on the Riser after the wood top is installed.




- 2. Open the Hutch door.
- 3. Use 4 pcs M6*48mm flange bolts (CC) in the 4 corners and tighten with a 8mm socket or wrench.
- 4. Using a 3/32 in. drill bit, pre-drill 5 holes into the wood top along the pegboard backwall. Be careful to only drill 1 in. deep.
- 5. Using an 8mm socket, install 5 pcs. ST5.5*25mm wood self-tapping screws (DD) into the pre-drilled holes in the wood top along the rear of the pegboard. Be careful not to overtighten.




6 Attach the LED light


1. The LED light has been pre-installed on the shelf. Remove the nylon cable ties bundled at both ends of the LED light, and removed the plastic bag.



2. Insert the power cable into the end of the LED fixture, and reposition so it's centered on the shelf. Note: The back of the LED fixture is magnetic and attaches directly to the holder under the shelf.




3. Use the Cable clips (II) to attach the power cord from the LED light and route the wire along the backwall to either the USB in the Hutch or the H61MWC15HP cabinet.




7 Attach the shelf in the hutch

1. Put the shelf into the inner cavity of Hutch at the desired height and fasten the 5 pcs Shelf Clips (EE) to the pegboard to align with the notches in the shelf.



8 Attach the storage hooks

1. Attach the Storage Hooks (FF) for the power cord on the back of the Hutch with 4 pcs Hex socket botton cap bolt (GG). 2. Tighten with L Hex Key (HH).




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Cordless Power Tool Battery Chargers

Maintenance


Lubricate the slides semi-annually with high-quality bearing grease.



- **Periodically clean the drawer fronts, drawer trim, and other surfaces with a mild detergent and water.**
- Remove grease and oil with a standard nonflammable cleaning fluid.
