



MEXICAN PALM THATCH

Care Instructions

Mexican palm thatch is a natural product and is subject to natural elements and degradation and some caution must be utilized.

1. Mexican palm thatch is not flame resistant and can ignite if installed too close to barbeques, fire pits, or any open flame situation. We recommend that you check with your local fire department and/or building department for specifics on conforming to code ***before installation***. There are fire retardant products that can be applied such as “Thatch Safe” and “X238” that are available and that may be required to conform to your local fire and/or building codes.
2. Mexican palm thatch can become moldy. If this happens, mix a solution of 5 parts water and 1 part bleach. Spray onto thatch for 5 minutes and then rinse with water. Best results will occur on a hot and sunny day. Best to do this early in the day to make sure the thatch dries completely.
