

Recliner Care & Maintenance Guide

● General Care

Weight Capacity: Do not exceed the recommended weight limit (typically 250–300 lbs unless otherwise specified). Overloading may cause structural damage.

Proper Use: Always sit fully on the seat before reclining. Avoid standing, jumping, or applying uneven pressure on the footrest or armrests.

Regular Inspection: Periodically check screws, bolts, and reclining mechanisms. Tighten if necessary to maintain stability and safety.

● Upholstery Care

Fabric Upholstery: Vacuum regularly with a soft brush attachment to remove dust and debris. Blot spills immediately with a clean, dry cloth. For stains, use a mild fabric cleaner and follow the manufacturer's instructions.

Leather/PU Upholstery: Wipe with a soft, damp cloth weekly. Avoid harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or direct sunlight exposure to prevent cracking or fading. Apply a leather conditioner every 6–12 months if applicable.

Microfiber Upholstery: Spot-clean using a mild soap solution. Gently rub with a soft cloth in circular motions. Allow to air dry naturally.

● Frame & Mechanism

Lubrication: Apply a small amount of furniture-safe lubricant to the reclining mechanism every 6–12 months to ensure smooth operation.

Avoid Moisture: Keep metal parts dry to prevent rust. If exposed to moisture, wipe immediately with a dry cloth.

Proper Handling: Do not force the recliner open or closed. Always use the designated lever or push-back function.

- **Placement & Environment**

Positioning: Place the recliner on a flat, stable surface. Ensure at least 12–18 inches of clearance between the back of the chair and the wall for full reclining.

Temperature & Humidity: Keep away from heat sources (radiators, fireplaces, direct sunlight) and excessive humidity to prevent warping, fading, or material damage.

Floor Protection: Use furniture pads or a rug to protect flooring and reduce movement.

- **Safety Precautions**

Not recommended for children to operate unsupervised.

Ensure pets and small objects are clear of the mechanism before reclining or closing.

Do not attempt to modify the structure or mechanism. Contact customer service for repairs if necessary.
