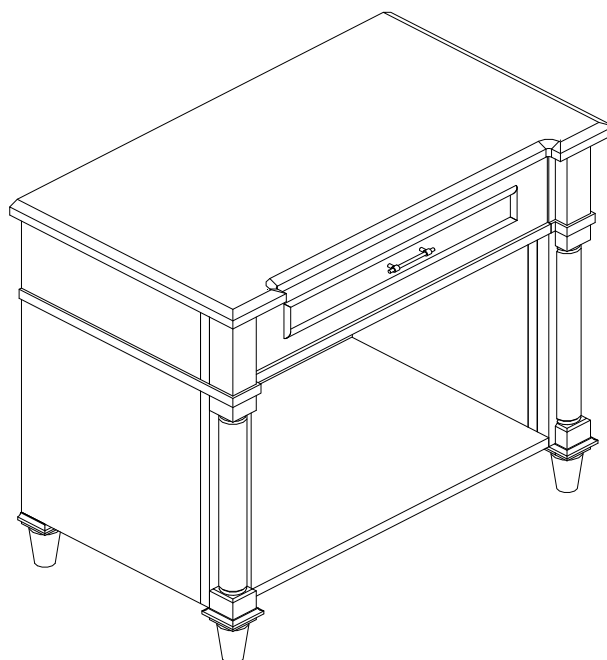

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# Safety Information



## DANGER

- Unit must be placed on a level surface or leveled with included hardware (when applicable).
- Do not sit or stand on or allow children to climb, sit or stand on the assembled product.
- For safety reasons, it is imperative that this unit be mounted on the wall or floor.
- Unit can tip over causing severe injury or death.
- Do not exceed the recommended weight limits.
- Evenly distribute the weight on each level and always keep the heavier loads on the bottom.
- Before cutting, drilling or hammering into any wall or floor surface, verify the location of electrical, plumbing and gas lines. Cutting may cause serious injury.



**NOTE:** If you are unsure about your wall type of what mounting method you should use, consult a qualified professional.



## CAUTION

- Do not use power tools to assemble your item. Power tools may strip or damage parts/product.
- Do not over tighten connectors (screws, bolts, etc.) Overtightening can lead to product damage.
- Be sure to check all packing materials carefully for small parts that may have come loose inside the carton during shipment. If parts are missing, contact THE HOME DEPOT to obtain any missing parts.
- DO NOT USE SUBSTITUTE PARTS.
- This product should only be used on a flat, level surface.
- Product is designed to hold [100lbs]. Exceeding this limit may damage the product or cause injury to the user.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the Unit or your floor.

- 1 Take the foot box out of the pull box.

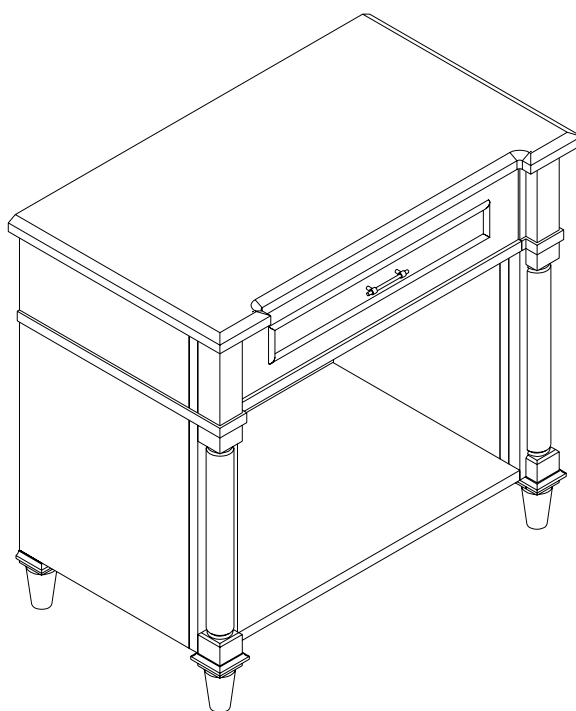
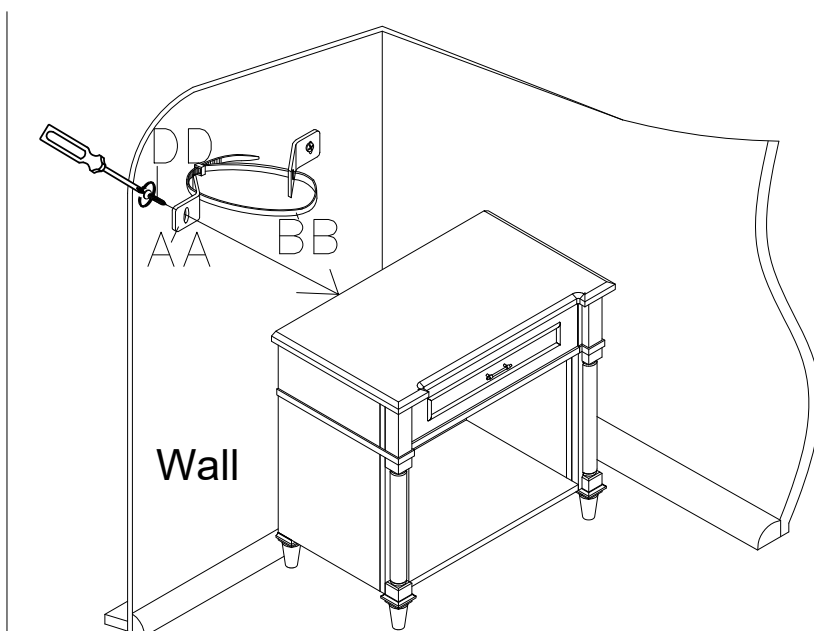
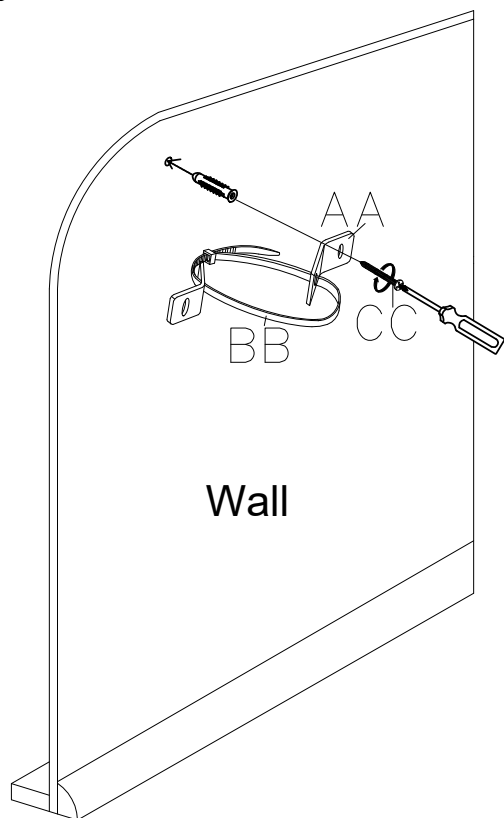


- 2 Assemble the nighstand to the leg .
  - Attaching the nightstand (A) to the leg (B).

- 3** The tipping restraint kit shall be securely attached to the back top rail of the furniture.

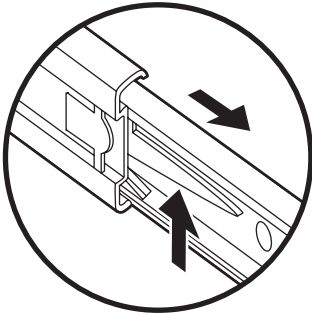

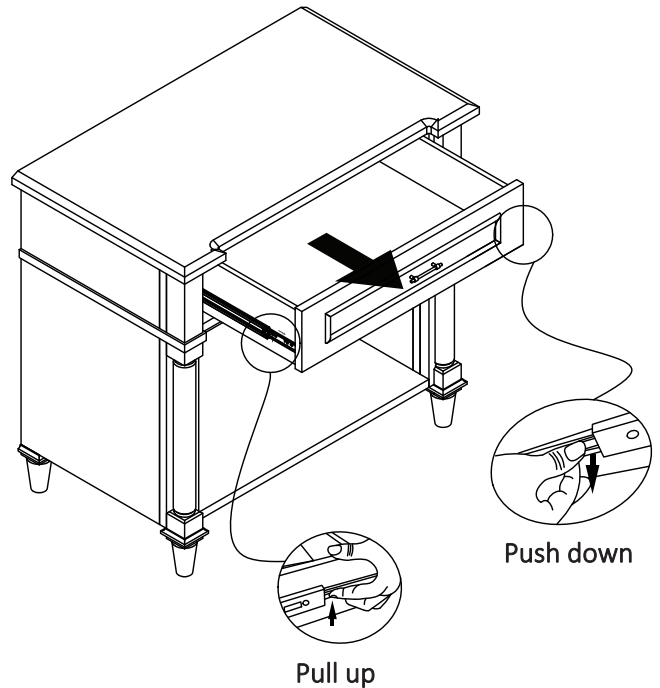
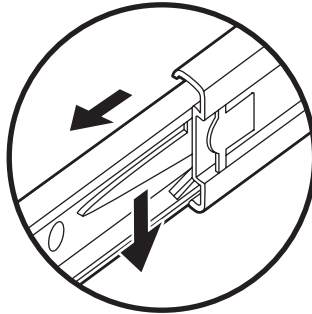
### 4 Removing the drawers

- Open the drawer as far as possible.
- Simultaneously, press the right side spring clip downward and the left side spring clip upward.
- Once both spring clips are held in the indicated position, pull the drawer straight out.

Left side view

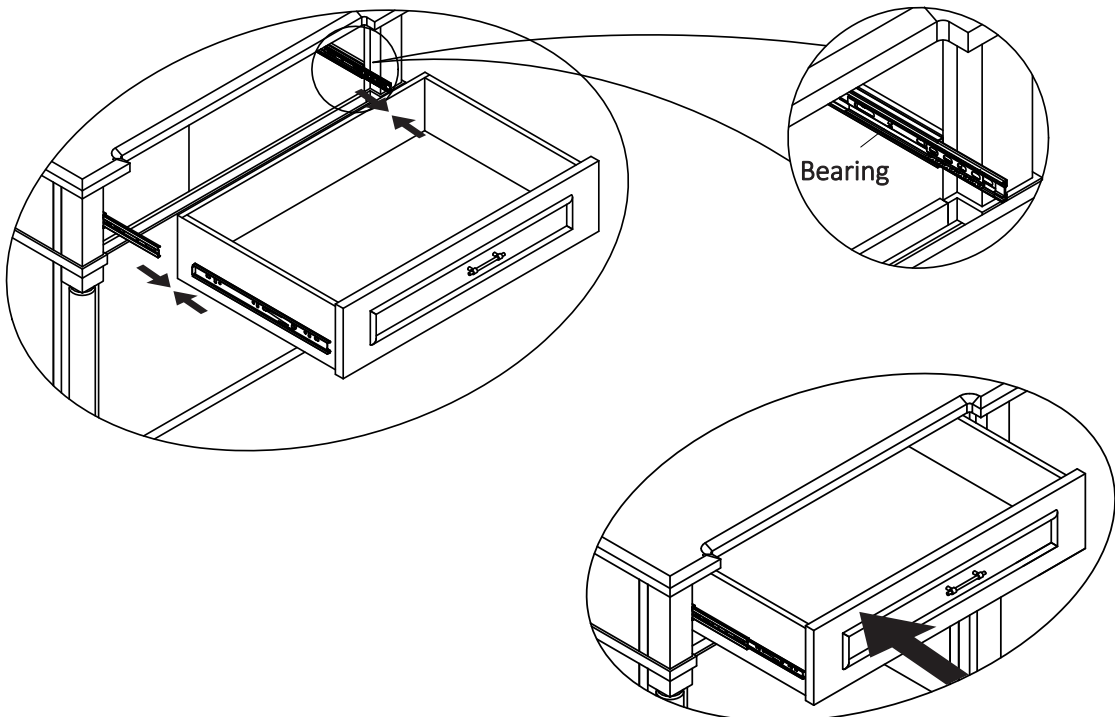


Right side view



### B. To Reinstall Drawers

- Insert the drawers by pulling cabinet tracks on both sides. All the way out (including ball bearing rack).
- Align tracks on drawer with sliders and push in the drawer until there is audible "click" sound.





## Maintenance

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- ☐ Please periodically check all fittings and re-tighten as necessary.
- ☐ Do not use this product if parts are missing, damaged or worn.

## Care and Cleaning

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- ☐ Never allow any kind of liquid to remain on your furniture. Absorption can cause wood to warp or finishes to de-laminate.
- ☐ Please do not drag and pull your furniture.
- ☐ Please do not place hot items (e.g. hot drinks) directly on the surfaces. Please make sure you use a placement or coaster.
- ☐ Remove the drawers then lift them if need moving. We recommend to make a marking before remove it then insert back in original position.
