

Safety Information

PRECAUTIONS

Use caution and common sense when using your outdoor fireplace. Failure to adhere to the safety warnings and guidelines in this manual could result in bodily injury or property damage. Save this manual for future reference.



DANGER: To prevent personal injury, burns, property damage, or even death, carefully monitor all activity and alert all persons in the vicinity of burning outdoor fireplaces of the dangers and safety precautions associated with open flame fireplaces. Do not use outdoor fireplaces where alcoholic beverages are being consumed.



DANGER: Keep children, pets, loose clothing, and hair safely away from the outdoor fireplace. Failure to adhere to this could lead to severe personal injury or possible death. Do not allow children to use or play near this outdoor fireplace.

DANGER: Do not use indoors due to the hazard of carbon monoxide fumes and fire. Lack of ventilation may cause death.



WARNING: For outdoor use only.

WARNING: Outdoor fireplaces are only to be used in a well ventilated area a minimum of 20 ft. from building walls, overhangs, trees, and so forth to prevent fires or melting of materials from buildings.




WARNING: Do not place the outdoor fireplace where flames could ignite combustible materials such as roof overhangs, wooden structures, fuel, clothing, fabric, or dry vegetation.

WARNING: To avoid fire hazards, never leave a burning outdoor fireplace unattended. If you must leave the area of the fire pit, ensure that all fire embers are extinguished.



WARNING: Never use gasoline, kerosene, alcohol, or other flammable fuel in or around the outdoor fireplace. Do not use the outdoor fireplace near gasoline or other flammable liquids, gases, or where flammable vapors may be present.

PLANNING ASSEMBLY





Assembly


Assembling the first two ring sections

- □ Align the bolt holes of two of the fire ring sections (A).
- Insert bolts (BB) through the holes of wall of both sections
 (A) and loosely secure with nuts (CC).
- □ Loosely secure with the bolt (AA) through the top edge of both sections (A).




$\mathbf{2}$ Assembling the third ring section

- □ Align the holes of the third ring section (A) with the ring assembly and attach using bolts (BB) and nuts (CC). Do not over tighten the nuts (cc).
- □ Loosely secure with the bolt (AA) through the top edge of both sections (A).




Attaching the final ring section

- □ Align the holes of the fourth ring section (A) with the ring assembly and attach using bolts (BB) and nuts (CC). Do not over tighten the nuts (CC).
- □ Loosely secure with the bolt (AA) through the top edge of both sections (A).



Completing the assembly

- Align the holes of the fourth ring section (A) with the first ring section (A) and secure together using bolts (BB) and nuts (CC).
- □ Loosely secure with the bolt (AA) through the top edge of both sections (A).
- □ Tighten all of the nuts (CC) with a wrench (not included).
- □ Tighten all of the bolts (AA) with an allen key (DD).



Care and Cleaning

- Once the fireplace is completely cooled down, pour the ashes from the fire ring and rinse with clean water and allow to dry completely.
- \Box Clean after each use.
- Do not use a scrub brush.
- □ If the paint chips, use only high-temperature paints and a brush to fix.
- □ If rust is showing, sand lightly and repaint the area with high-temperature paints.
- $\hfill\square$ Dry with a soft cloth.
- $\hfill\square$ Cover the unit when not in use to prolong the life.
- $\hfill\square$ \hfill Keep your fire ring out of rain.
