

# Purple Daydream® Dwarf Loropetalum

*Loropetalum chinense* 'PPI' PP25471

This petite beauty displays dark purple foliage year-round and bursts with lovely pink string clusters each spring. Purple Daydream™ is versatile, handling full sun to part shade, as well as offering drought tolerance and deer resistance. A compact loropetalum, it spreads nicely into a mound reaching 2-3 feet high by 3-4 feet wide.

## **Planting Instructions**

- Water before planting
- Plant in full sun to part shade
- Dig hole 2X the width of pot
- Backfill and plant 1"-2" above soil level
- Water and add more soil if needed
- Mulch plants
