ANDOVA TILE CARE AND MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS:

Glass Tiles:

For normal cleaning, wipe down the tile surface with a damp sponge or rag. A solution of water and light vinegar can be used.

If stronger cleaning is needed, use a non abrasive PH neutral cleaner.

Clean spills and dirt immediately if possible.

Stone and Marble Tiles:

For normal cleaning and maintenance, use a few drops of neutral cleaner, stone soap, or mild liquid dish soap mixed with warm water.

Too much cleaner or soap may leave a surface film over or cause streaks.

Do not use any cleaner that contains lemon, vinegar or other acids on marble or stone.

Wash the tile surface well when you're done, and dry with a soft cloth.

Clean spills and dirt immediately if possible.

Porcelain and Ceramic Tiles:

Porcelain and ceramic tiles can be cleaned via mopping, sweeping or vacuuming.

For washing, use a non abrasive, neutral cleaner, like vinegar.

Do not clean the tiles with ammonia, or with products that contain bleach or acid. It is also not recommended to use agents that contain dye or color.

Do not use steel wool sponges to scrub the tiles, as loose fibers may create rust stains on the grout.

For best results on floor tiles:

Sweep the floor in two different directions across the tile surface. Then soak the floor in a thin layer of cleaning solution for 5-10 minutes. Scrub the floor well, then mop away the solution. Dry the floor well when the mopping is completed.

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
