

- Place all wooden parts on a clean , flat , and soft surface (e.g. carpet or rug) to prevent scratch and damage to parts .





Attach front rail(E) to left leg(F) and right leg(G) with screws(GG).




5 Attach left leg(F) to left side rail (C)and right leg(G) to right side rail (D) with screw(GG).




# Assembly


- 1 Attach seat panel to backrest frame
  - ☐ Use allen key (DD) to tighten 4 screws(EE) with washers(CC&BB) to fix seat panel(B) to backrest frame(A)



2 Use allen key(DD) to drive screw(AA) with washers (CC&BB)as shown,make sure the seat panel(B) and backrest frame(A) more stable.



3 Attach left side rail(C) and right side rail(D) to the backframe legs, drive screw(GG) tightly.



Fix left leg(F) and right leg(G) to seat panel (B) with screw(FF) and washers (CC&BB) by allen key(DD)
