

Warranty

TWO YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

WHAT IS COVERED

The frame is warranted to be free of manufacturing defects for two year from the purchase date. If the frame of your furniture fails (ie. broken frame or weld) within two year of ownership, Hampton Bay will repair, provide replacement parts, or replace the product at our option. Frame finishes are warranted against blistering, cracking, or peeling for two year from purchase date. This is a residential use warranty only. Warranty is void when product is used for commercial settings. This warranty is a limited warranty and applies to the original purchase only. Proof of purchase is required.

Care and Cleaning

- Use mild soap and warm water to clean the frames.
- Rinse with clean water and dry thoroughly.
- Be sure to drain any water accumulated inside the frames. To thoroughly drain frames, remove footcaps and tilt frames, if
 necessary, to remove all water. Water allowed to accumulate inside the frames and then exposed to sub-freezing temperatures can
 cause damage to frame tubing. Such damage caused by conditions other than normal is not covered under warranty.
- Any rust spots should be lightly sanded and treated with rust inhibitor and followed with an application of touch-up paint (not included).

Assembly

PLANNING ASSEMBLY

Before beginning the assembly of this product, make sure all parts are present. Compare parts with Package Contents and Hardware Included lists. If any part is missing or damaged, do not attempt to assemble the product, and return it to the place of purchase. Assembly requires two people.


1 Attaching the Front Legs to the Chaise Seat

- □ Place all parts on a flat, clean surface.
- Attach the Front Legs (A) to the Chaise Seat (B), by using Bolts (AA), Larger Washers (EE) and Hex Wrench (GG).
- Do not overtighten the bolts.




Inserting the Armrest to the Legs

- Insert the Armrests (E) to the Center Leg (C) and Back Leg (D), by using the Bolts (BB), Washers (DD) and Hex Wrench (GG).
- Do not overtighten the bolts.




3 Attaching the Assembled Seat to the Legs

- Attach the Assembled Seat to the Center Legs (C) and Back Legs (D), by using the Bolts (CC), Small Washers (DD).
- □ Tighten all the bolts with Hex Wrench (GG).




4 Connecting the Chaise Back to the Seat


 Connect the Chaise Back (F) to the assembled Seat (as shown), using the Bolts (CC), Small Washers (DD) and Plastic Washers (FF).



Put the Cushions on the Chaise

- $\hfill\Box$ Put the Seat Cushion (G) and Back Cushion (H) on the Chaise.
- Now the Chaise is ready for use.
