


Maxx Air **18" Wall Mount Poultry Fan**

Your Maxx Air fan is shipped fully assembled. Enjoy the powerful, cooling breeze that the fan will provide for virtually any indoor application. There are no additional spare parts shipped with this item.

Specifications

Totally enclosed motor meets NEC 547-7 (2008) requirements for use in Agricultural Areas. This unit has a 110-120 Volt A/C polarized grounded plug. Do not remove grounding conductor from plug or use with an extension cord.

Warning

To reduce the risk of fire or electric shock, do not use with any solid state speed control device. This fan motor is equipped with an automatic reset overload device. The fan may start unexpectedly. Do not put any object through the grilles into the blade or motor. This fan is designed for indoor use only. Do not use to exhaust hazardous chemicals or vapors. Unplug unit for storage, when not in use or moving locations.

Installation

Minimum Attachment Requirements: 2x4 studding capable of supporting at least 50 lbs. Use a 3/8" diameter x 2" long Lag Screw with flat WARNING



washer (Fig.1 not included). Attach the fan to wall using the hole in the wall bracket with the above mentioned lag screw.

Additional screws can be used to stabilize the wall mount if needed, however they are not required.

- 2. Do Not use any cleaning solution that is harmful to the paint or plastic.
- 3. Do Not bend blade when cleaning fan.

- 5. Ensure all fan guards are reinstalled as previously installed after cleaning.

Repairs or replacement parts supplied under this warranty are warranted only for the period of this warranty; that is, one (1) year from the date of the original retail purchase of the unit.

In the event of a defect or malfunction, we will replace or repair the defective part or component only and return the new or repaired part to you freight prepaid.

You must bear all other expenses incurred in obtaining repairs, including labor required for field repair or replacement, and the cost of shipping the defective part to us. You must also bear the cost of repair to or replacement of any part or component and the shipping charges incurred for the repair or replacement and return to you of any part or component not covered by this warranty, including parts or components damaged by you.

The company reserves the right to demand and receive written evidence of the date of purchase before undertaking its obligations under this warranty. The right to demand and receive written evidence of date of purchase extends to all licensed dealers of Ventamatic, Ltd. products.
