





#### 7. Extension cord

- Follow all manufacturers' Warnings and Operating Instructions for your extension cord.
- □ Do not insert extension cord through hole without grommet in place.
- Only use a three-wire extension cord with all three prongs intact. Never remove the round grounding prong.
- Extension cord must be connected to a 125 Volt GFCI protected outlet with proper ground. If GFCI outlet is not available, use an extension cord with GFCI protection built in.
- Check the insulation and plugs of extension cord before using. Do NOT use cord if it is worn or damaged.
- □ Do NOT overload extension cord.
- □ Remove extension cord from the hole before moving or transporting Hutch.







## 1 Drill attachment holes

- □ Align and fix the Drill template (AA) on the back left corner of the stainless steel top of the Husky Professional 72in Workbench, flush with the left edge. Figure 1:1.
- □ Use a marker to mark hole locations A, B, C. Figure 1:2.
- □ Align the Template (AA) on the back right corner, flush with the right edge and mark hole locations B, C, D. Figure 1:3.
- □ Align the Template (AA) on the front right corner, flush with the right edge and mark hole locations A. Figure 1:4.
- □ Flip the Template (AA) over and align with the front left corner, and mark only hole location D. Figure 1:5.
- □ There should be a total of 8 marked hole locations on the steel work top. Ensure correct, per Figure 1:6.
- □ Use a hammer and punch to create a small divot in the steel top at each of the marked locations for the drill bit to align.






# 2 Attach the Hutch to the Workbench




**CAUTION:** Two people are required for assembly.

- □ Remove the 2 side handles and 8 bolts (not included with Hutch) from the existing 72 in. 20-Dr. Workbench and temporarily attach to the Hutch to help with lifting for assembly. The handles can be re-installed on the 72 in. 20-Dr. Workbench once the Hutch assembly is complete.
- □ Carefully lift the Hutch (A) and gently place on the Workbench.
- □ Open the Hutch door and check for proper alignment of the connection holes through the steel work surface. Ensure the Hutch is flush with the front and sides of the Workbench.




- □ Use 8 pcs M6\*48mm flange bolts (BB) to secure the Hutch along the sides and back to the Workbench. Tighten with a 8mm socket or wrench.
- □ Be careful not to over tighten.




# **3** Attach the LED light


□ The LED light has been pre-installed on the shelf. Remove any packing materials and the nylon cable ties bundled at both ends of the LED light.



Insert the power cable into the end of the LED fixture, and reposition so it's centered on the shelf.
 Note: The back of the LED fixture is magnetic and attaches directly to the articulating holder under the shelf.




- ☐ The LED is equipped with a dimmer function built into the power switch.
- □ Touch the power switch button once for 100% output. Touch again for 50%, again for 20%, and again for OFF.
- □ The Motion Sensor (II) is magnetic and can be installed where best suited according to your preference.
- □ It is equipped with an On/Off button and the LED can work with or without the Motion sensor. Once motion is detected, the LED stays on for approximately 150 seconds and will turn off if no motion is further detected.
- □ The dimmer setting (100%, 50% or 20%) is saved each time the Motion sensor turns the LED on and off.
- Plug the transformer cable into the motion sensor and route the cable through the access grommet to a power source.






# 4 Attach the Shelf in the Hutch


□ Put the Shelf (B) into the inner cavity of Hutch (A) at the desired height and install the 5 pcs Shelf Clips (CC) to the pegboard to align with the notches in the Shelf.




# **5** Attach the Transformer Holders

- □ Secure the LED Transformer (D) to the back of the Hutch using the 2 the Transformer Holders (GG) with 4 pcs Hex socket button cap bolt (EE).
- □ Tighten with Hex Key (HH).






□ Use the Cable clips (FF) to attach the power cord from the LED light and route the wire along the backwall to connect to the Motion Sensor(II).



# **6** Attach the Storage Hooks


- □ Attach the Storage Hooks (DD) for the power cord on the back of the Hutch with 12 pcs Hex button botton cap bolt (EE).
- □ Tighten with Hex Key (HH).





# **7** Remove the plastic plug (Optional)

□ Remove the 8 plastic plugs (KK) and 6 plastic plugs (LL) from the hutch side panels if needed.



# 8 Kwikset Smartkey® Lock Operation

- □ This product has been equipped with the Kwikset Smartkey® locks which allow you to easily program each lock cylinder to a specific key code to match other Kwikset keyed products.

### **Cordless Power Tool Battery Chargers**


