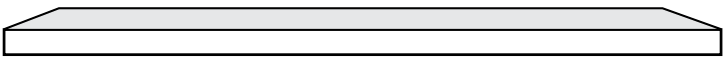

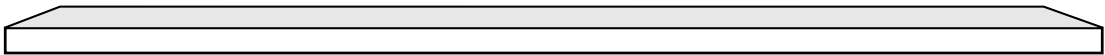

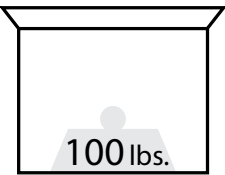


48" Worktop. Fits over 2 Cabinets

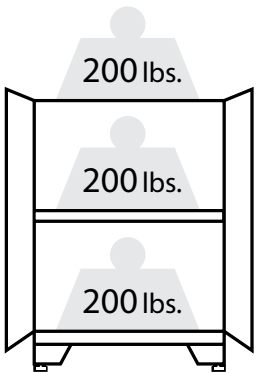


72" Worktop. Fits over 3 Cabinets

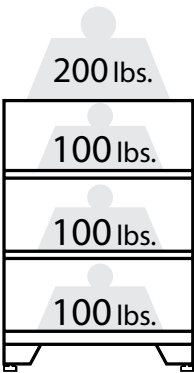

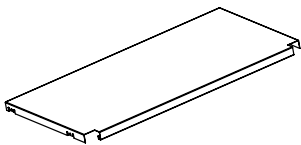


Unpacking

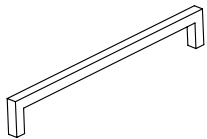
- Begin by placing the package on a covered flat surface.

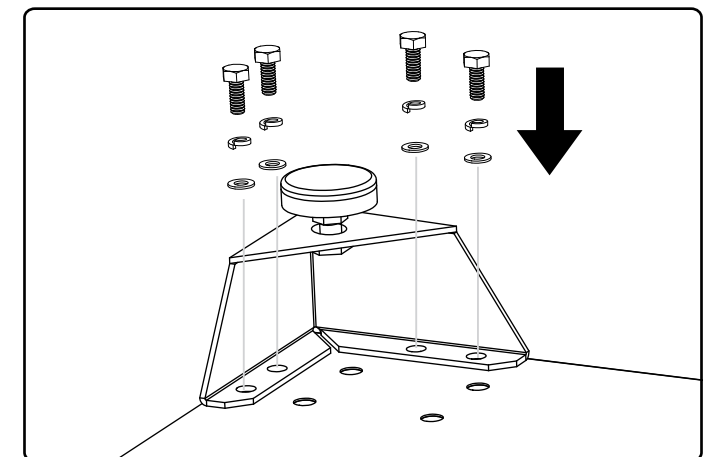
1 Open cabinet, remove any shelves or loose items.



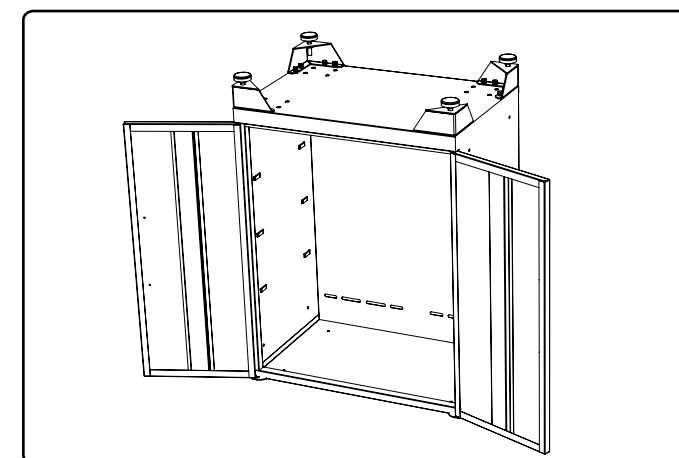
2 Flip cabinet upside down, locate holes at corners.



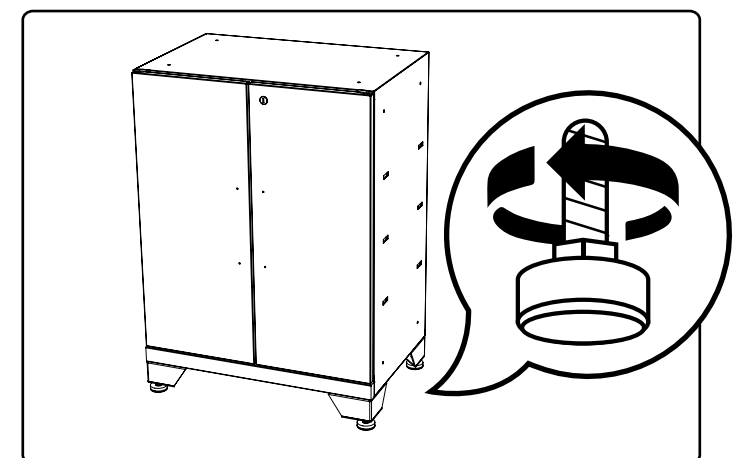
3 Align foot with edge of cabinet. Screw in 4 x Hex bolts with washer and lock washer.



4 Repeat steps 3 for each corner.




5 Stand & level feet.




Installing the Handles

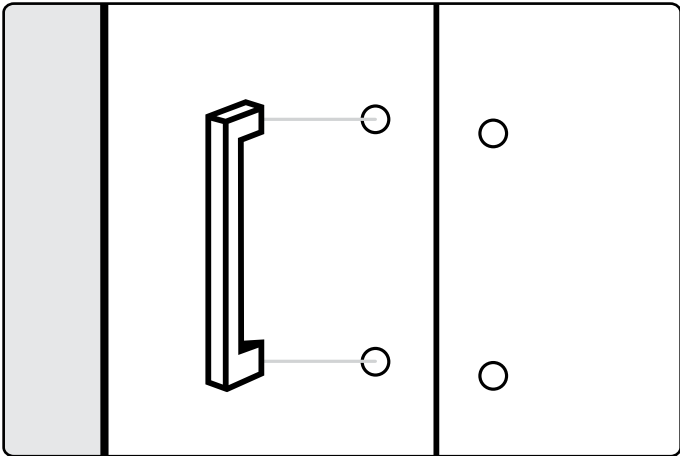


Handle Bolt

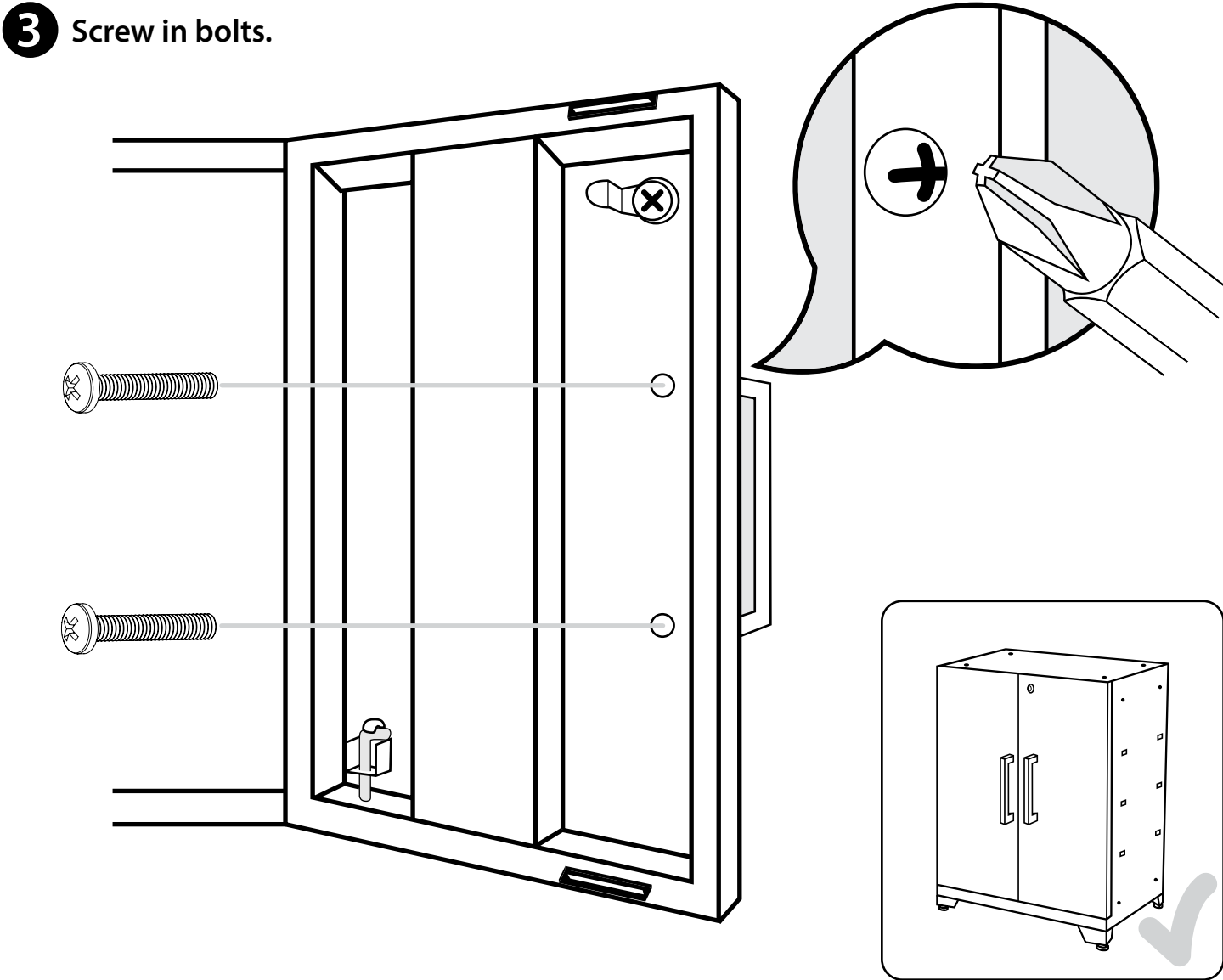
Base/Locker: 2 Handles and 4 Handle Bolts

2 Align Handle to holes on doors or drawers.

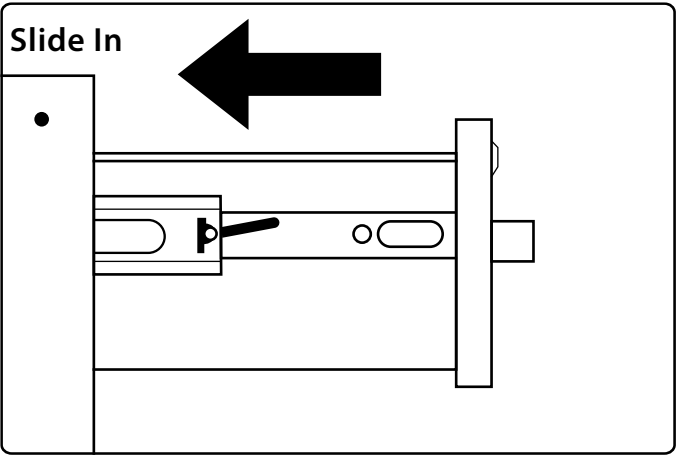
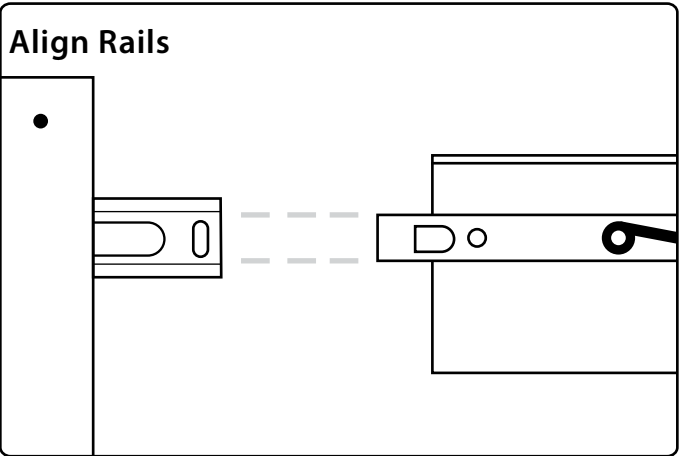

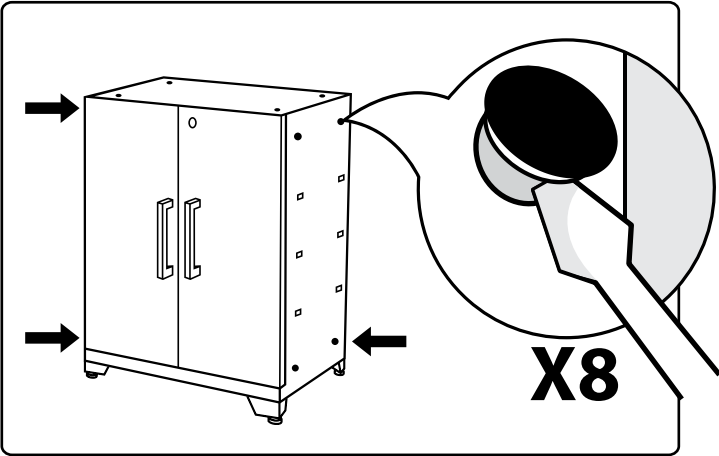


Fastening Cabinets

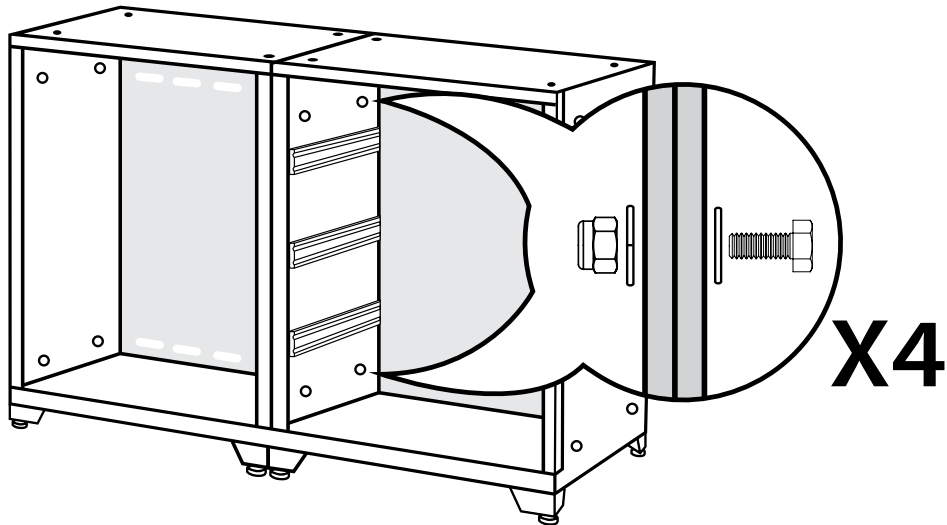
1 Parts Needed.



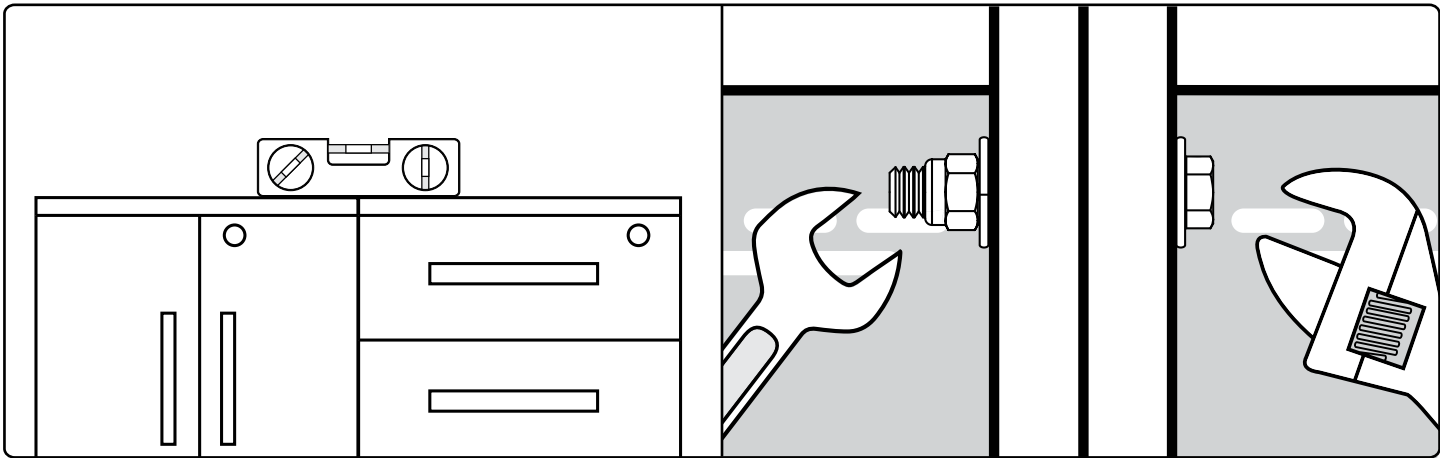
2 Remove plastic caps from cabinets.

4 Level cabinets and tighten all bolts.

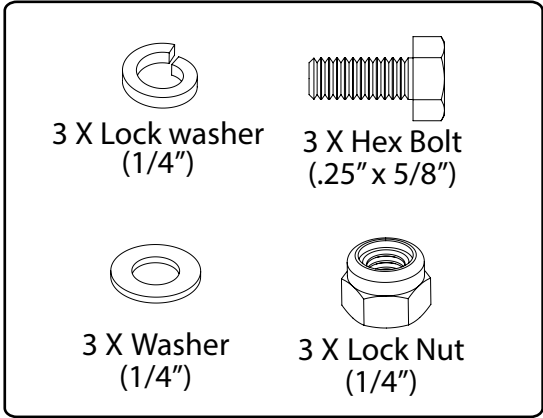

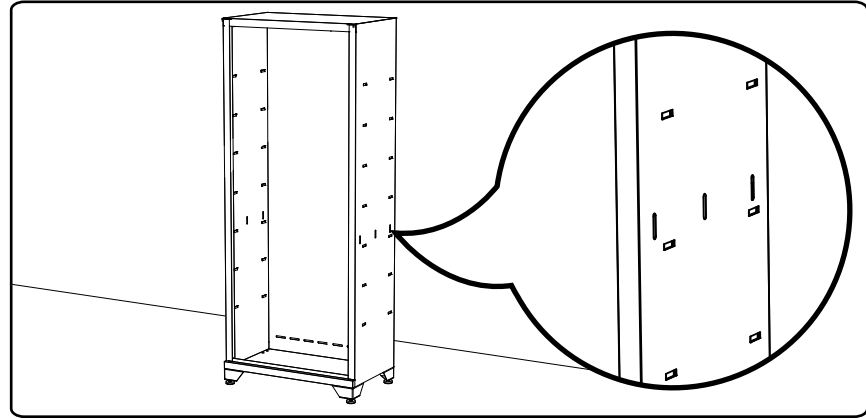
Installing Worktop Side Support Bracket

A support bracket is to be used if the worktop is added to the set without a secondary supporting base/tool cabinet.

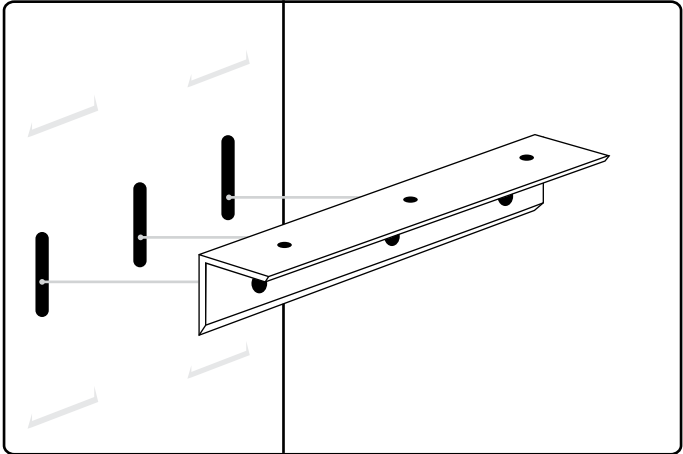
i Parts Needed.



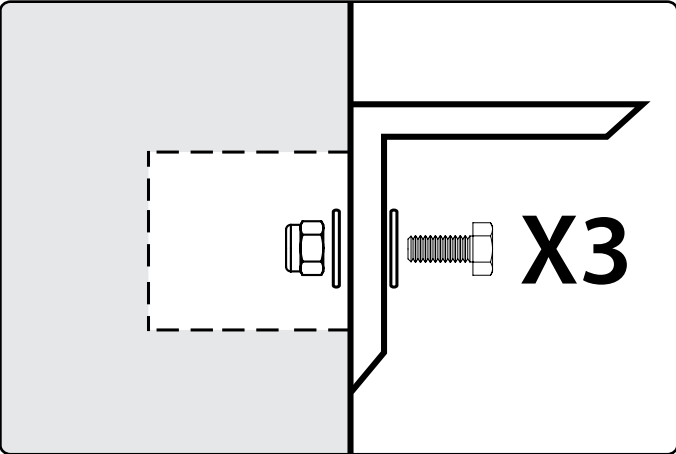
1 Open locker and locate slots on either side.



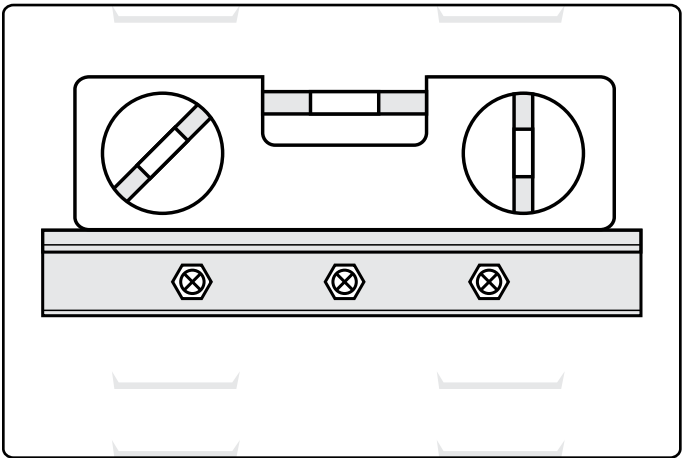
2 Align bracket.



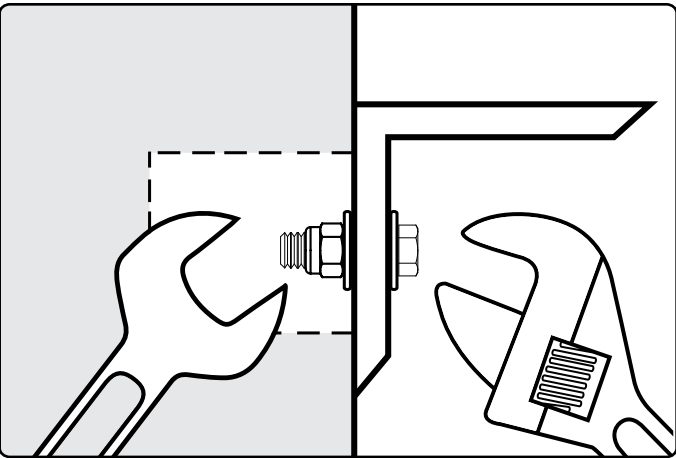
3 Fasten nuts, bolts, and lock washers.



5 Level bracket and ensure it is at the same height as the base cabinet.

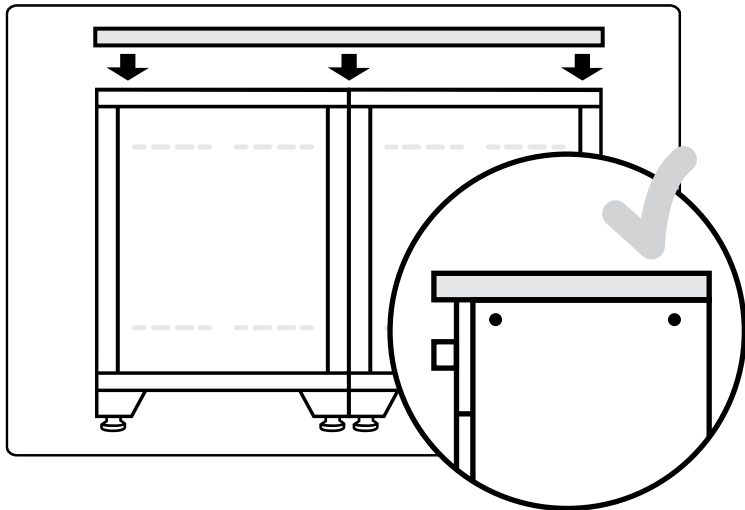


4 Tighten nuts & bolts.

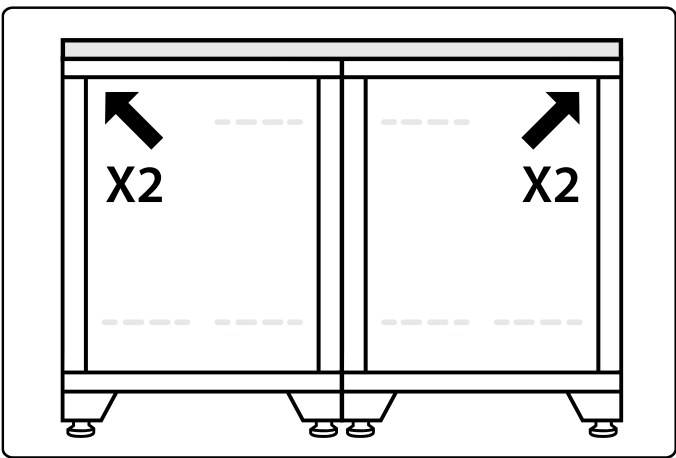


Mounting the Worktop (On 2 Cabinets)

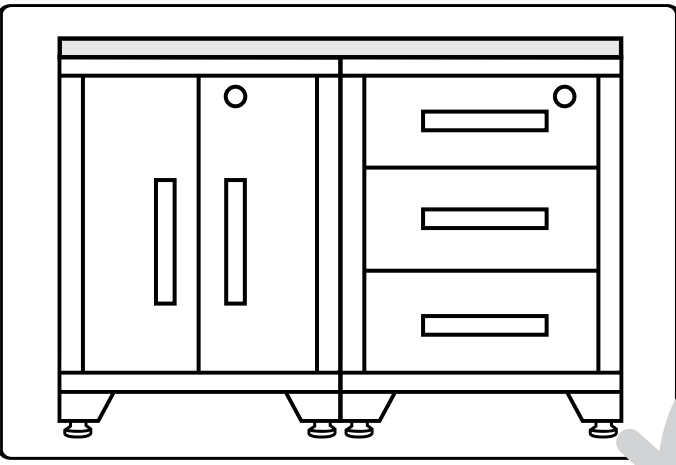
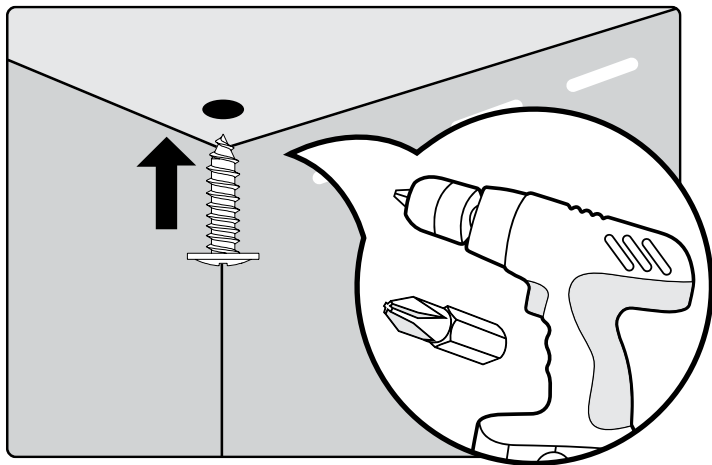
1 Place Worktop on cabinets.



2 Locate 2 punch holes both sides.

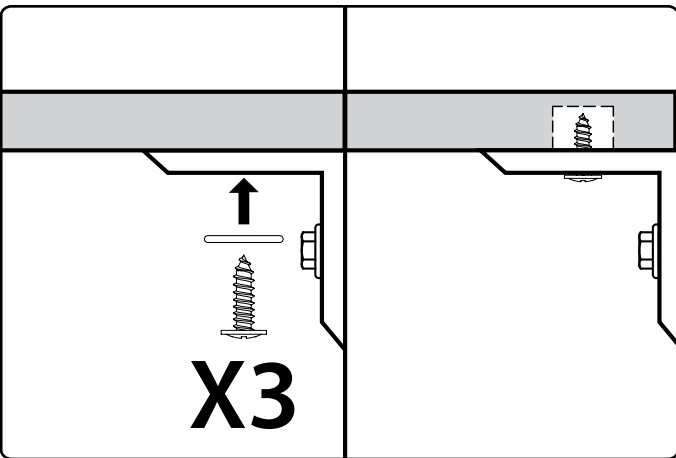
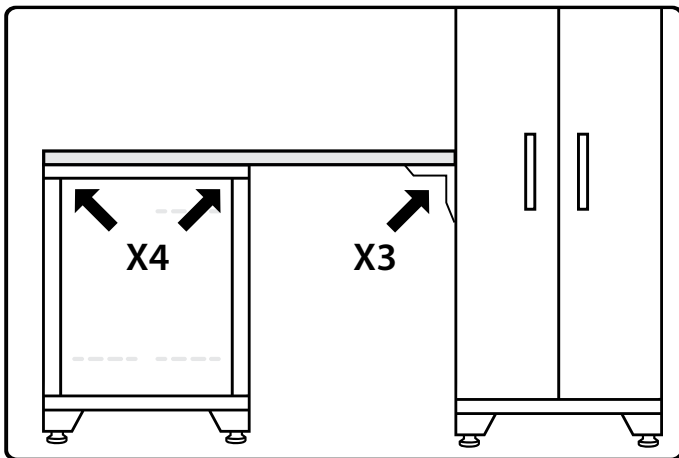


3 Drill into the worktop using the #8 x .5/8" wood screws.



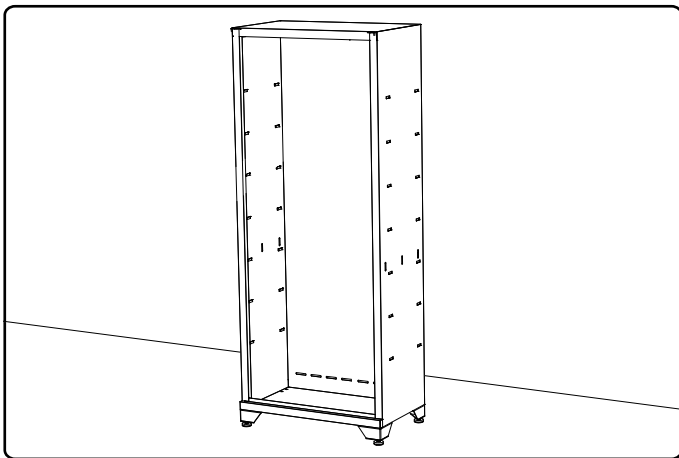
i Optional: For locker support bracket.

Use 3 washers & #8 x 5/8" wood screws. Provided in the locker packaging.

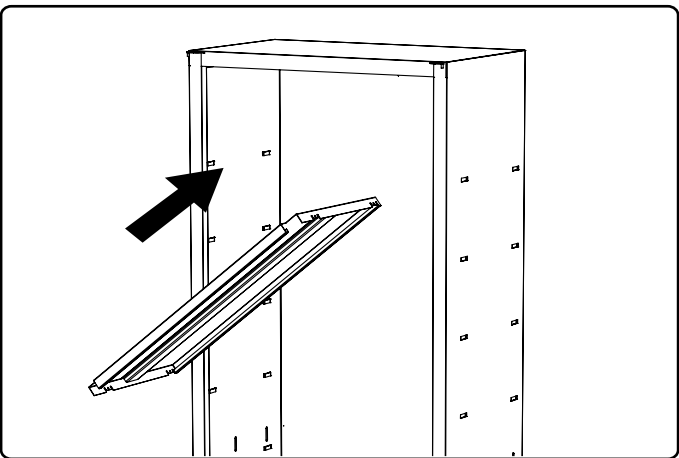


Inserting Cabinets Shelves

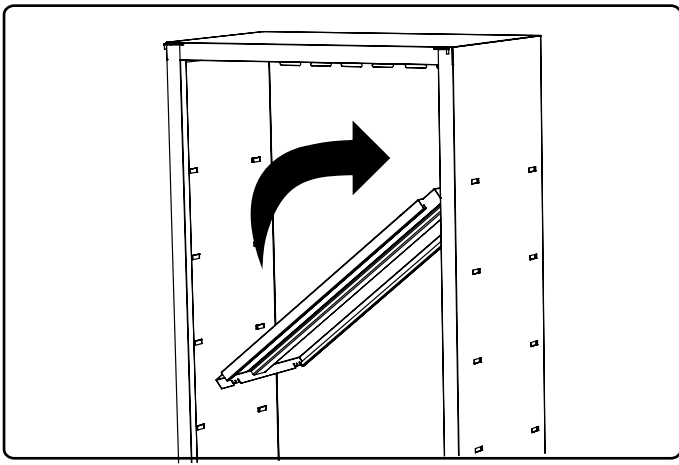
1 Stand cabinet up.



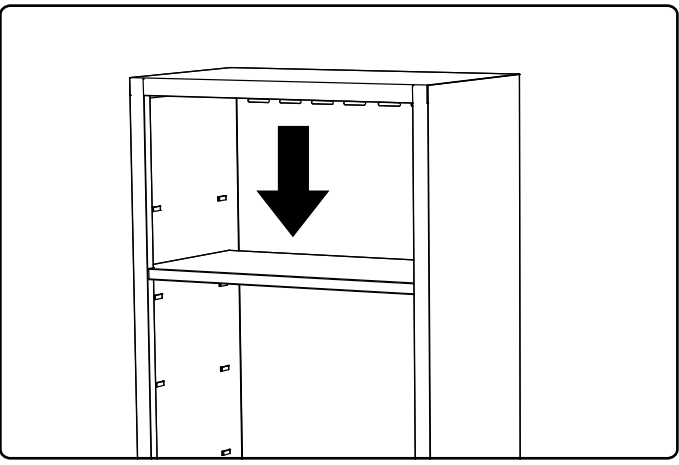
2 Insert shelf on 45 degree angle.



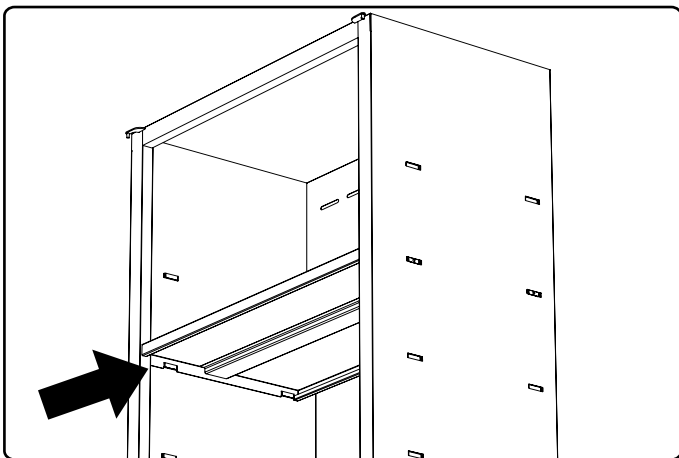
3 Rotate shelf to horizontal position.



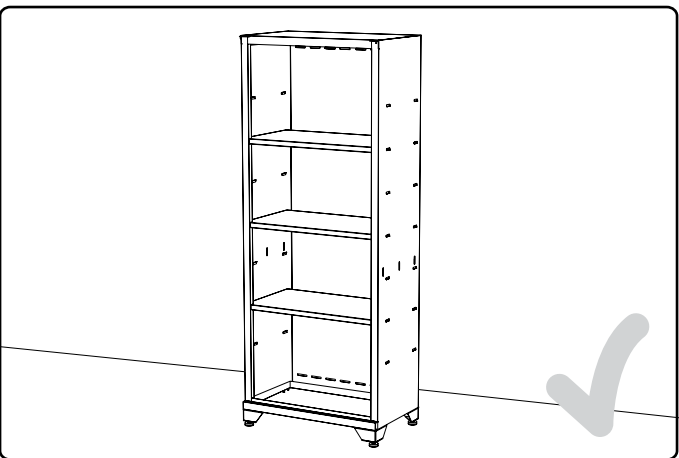
4 Push shelf down into grooves.



5 Ensure shelf is secure.

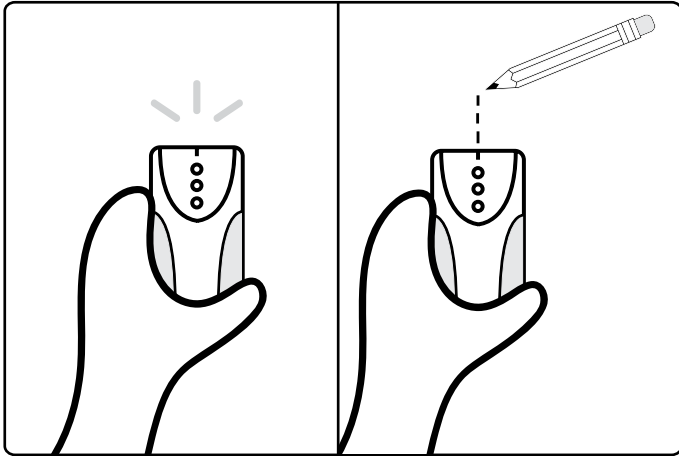


6 Insert remaining shelves.

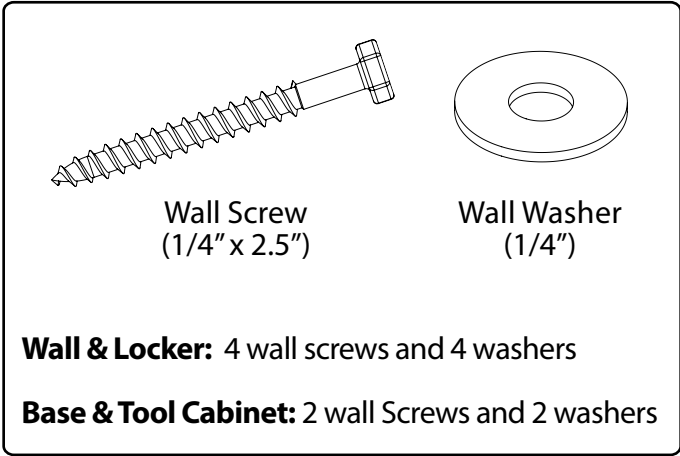


Mounting Cabinets (Drywall/Studded Wall)

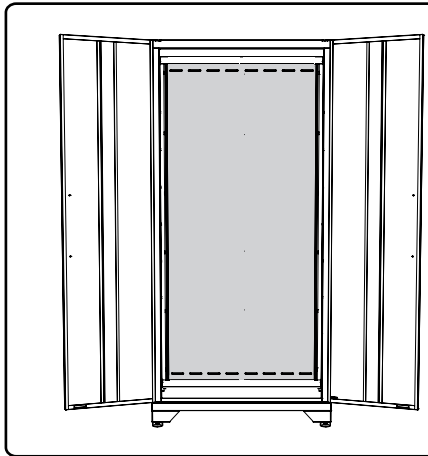
1 Use stud finder to locate the studs and mark the wall with a pencil.



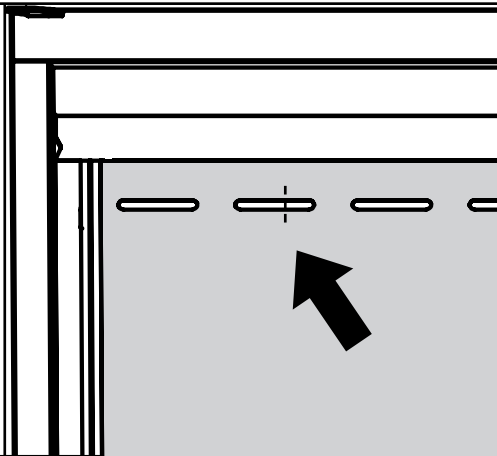
2 Gather parts.



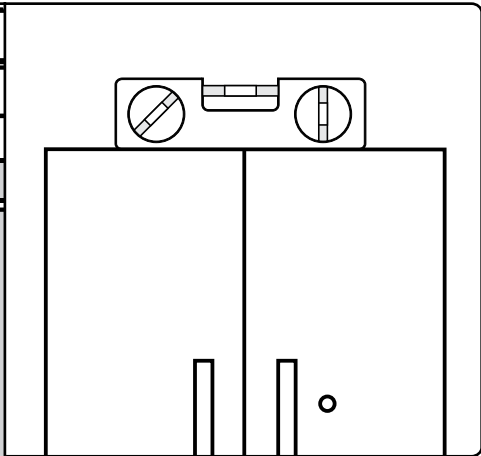
3 Place cabinet tight against the wall.



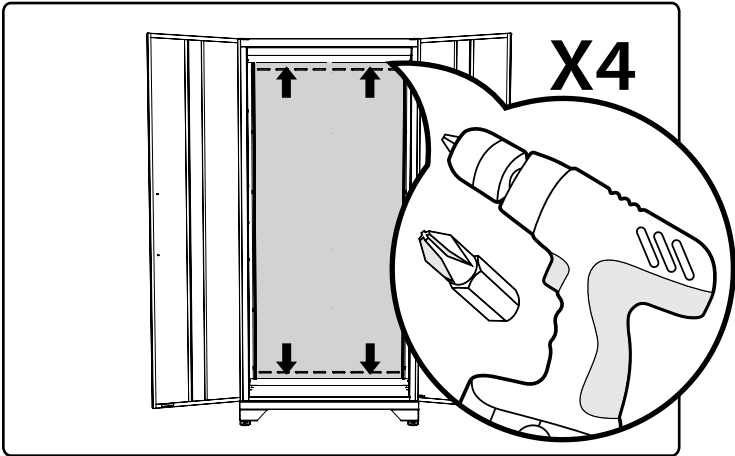
4 Align cabinet to stud marks.



5 Level cabinet



6 Drill 4 wall screws and washers through perforated holes into studs.



Masonry.

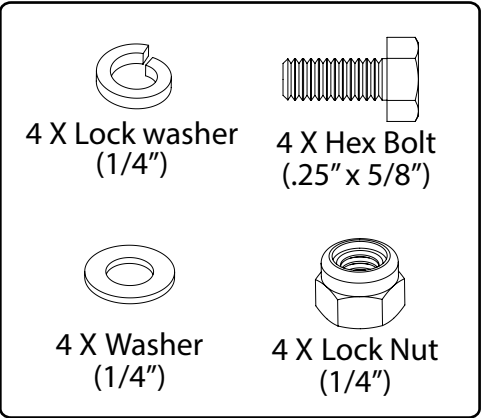
- Follow steps 1 to 5.
- Drill 4 pilot holes through the perforated strip with hammer drill & masonry bit.
- Use 4 x (2 1/4" x 1/4") Tapcon Concrete Anchor into wall. (Not Included)
- OR 4 x (#10 x 2") Screw with 3/16" masonry plug into wall. (Not Included)
- Follow Step 6.

Fastening Cabinets (Optional)

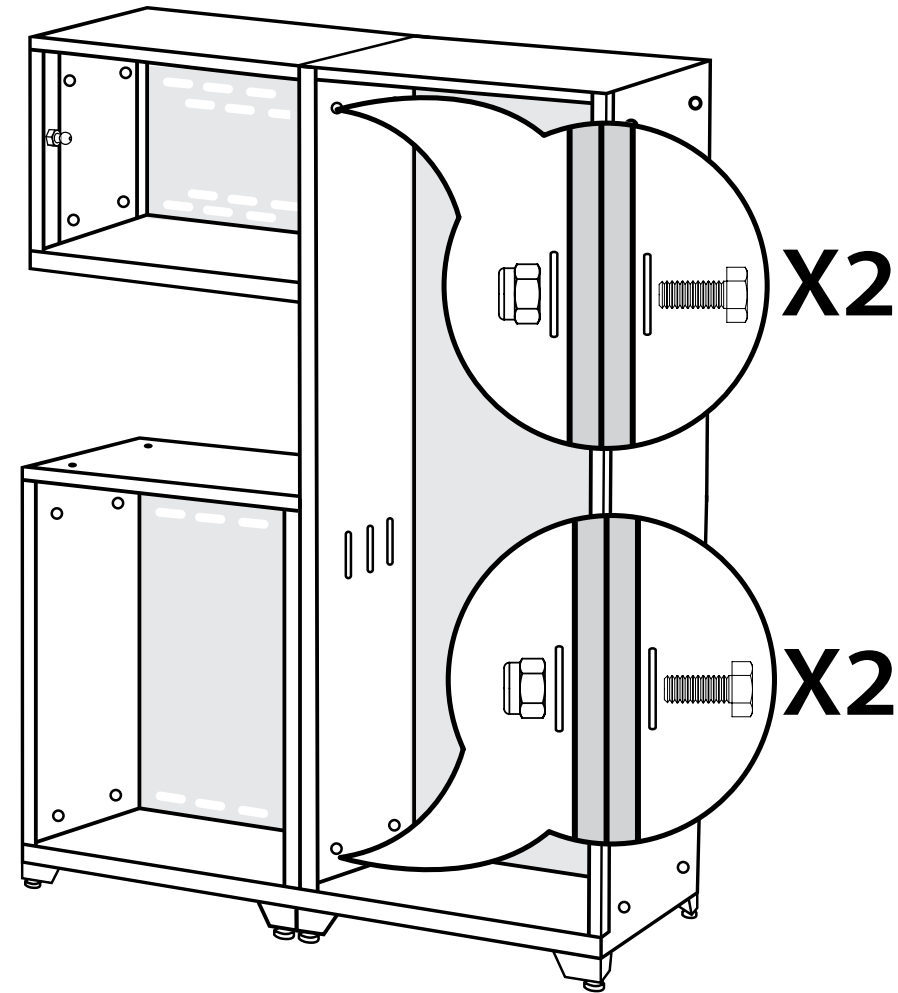
