

Assembly Instru

Caution: You must read this before










Read all instructions before assembling and using this product.

1. Select ideal location. Set out all parts on a clear and level surface. The Gazebo should be set up in the desired location to avoid damage to the lawn.
2. Team Work. We recommend 4-5 adults and it may require assistance to assemble the Gazebo. If possible, please use safety ladders.
3. Use caution. During the entire assembly process, especially when using ladders, pay attention to safety. No one other than the assembler should be in the work area.
4. Check all available parts. Before assembling your Gazebo, check the parts described in the Parts List.
5. Ensure that ALL BOLTS are fully and securely bolted in before attaching the Canopies.
6. Keep children away. Children shouldn't be allowed in the work area with parts and tools. Do not allow children to climb the Gazebo.
7. It is recommended that the curtain and mosquito netting be used in appropriate conditions.




• Do not assemble on flooring or carpet



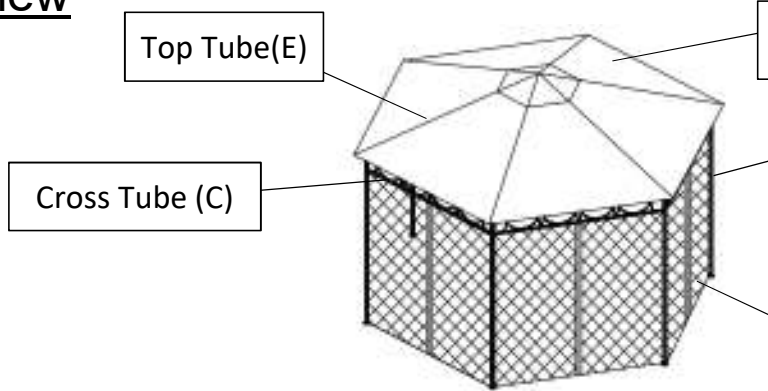

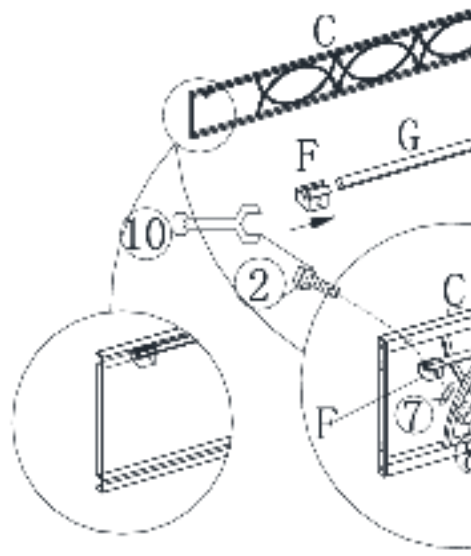
Assembly Preparation

Overview



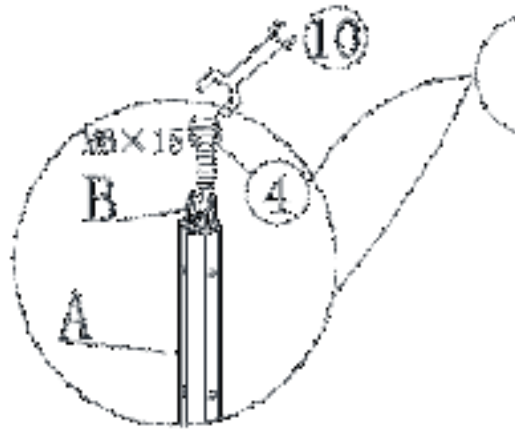
This Gazebo has multiple parts and may require up to 3 hours. This is an overview of the Gazebo parts, the above picture is to help you get a perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarize yourself with the steps before assembly.

Step 1



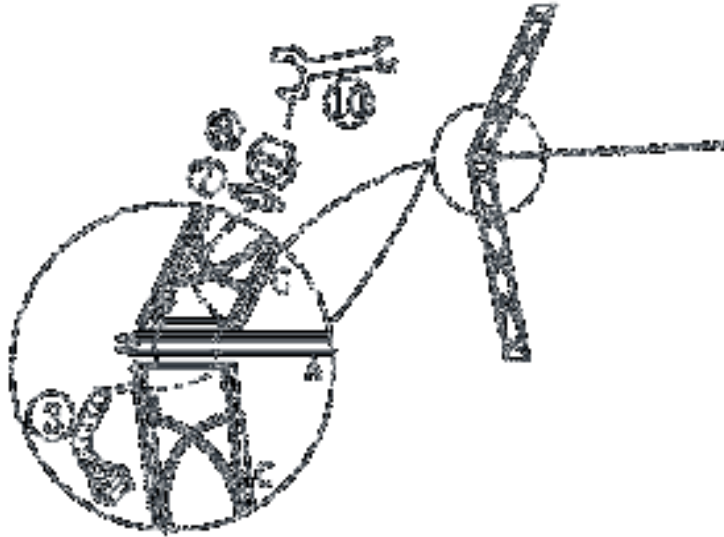
- 1.1)** Insert Connectors(F) onto both ends of Rails(G) as show
1.2) Attach Rails(G) to Cross Tubes(C) using Bolts(②), Wash Connectors(F), tightening with Spanners(⑩).
Tighten the Bolts fully in a sequential manner.

Step 2



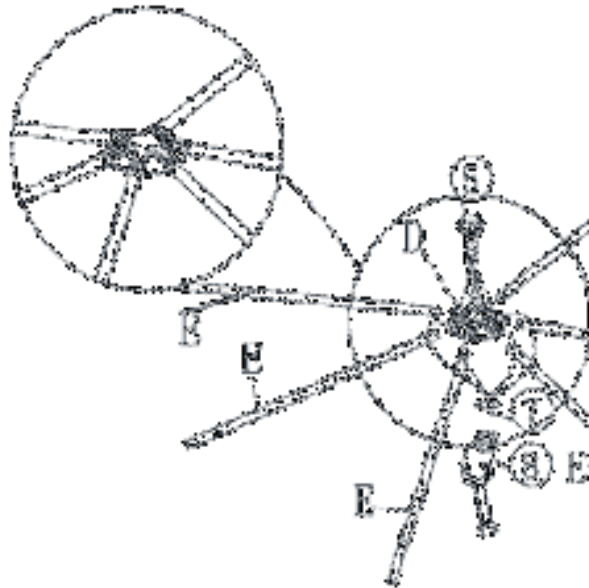
- Attach Steel Connectors(B) to Leg Tubes(A) using Bolts(④).
Tighten the Bolts fully in a sequential manner.

Step 3



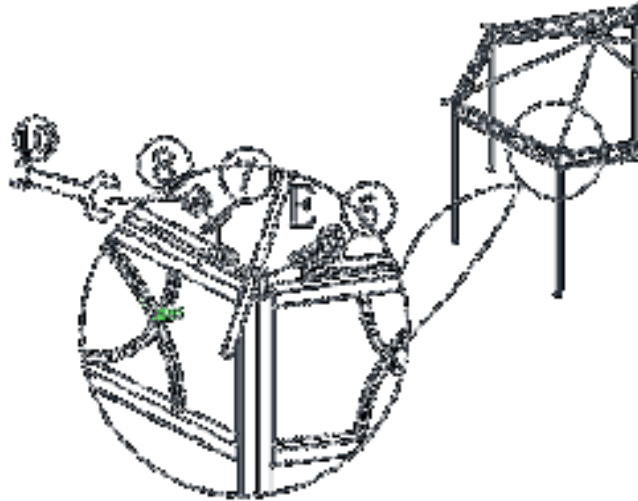
Attach Leg Tube(A) between Cross Tubes(C) using Bolts(3),
Spanners(10).
Tighten the Bolts fully in a sequential manner.

Step 4



Attach Top Tubes(E) to Top Connector(D) using Bolts(5), W
Spanners(10).
Tighten the Bolts fully in a sequential manner.

Step 5

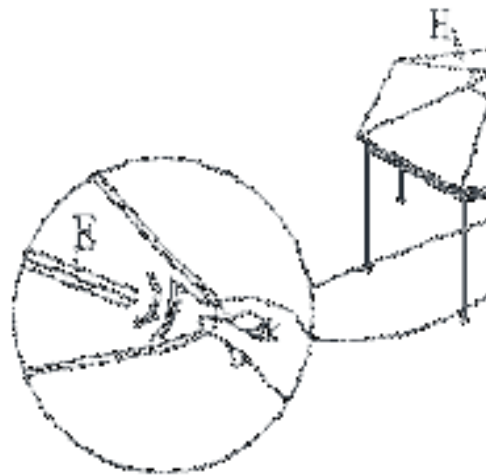


Attach Top Tubes(E) to Leg Tubes(A) using Bolts(⑥), Washers(⑩).

Tighten the Bolts fully in a sequential manner.

Note: Please use a ladder, if you can't reach it.

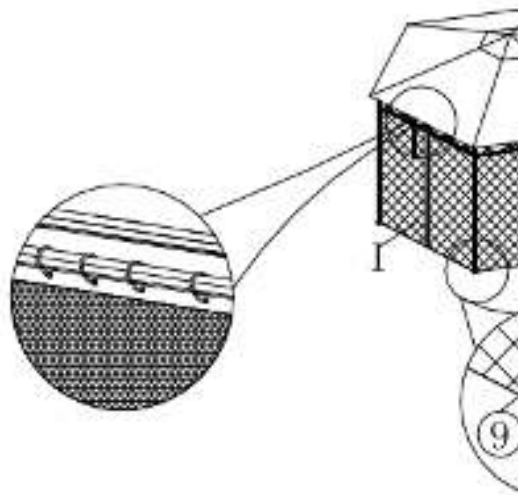
Step 6



Place the Cover(H) onto the Top Tubes(E) as pictured.

Note: Please use a ladder, if you can't reach it.

Step 7



7.1) Put the Hooks(①) onto the Rails(G).

7.2) Install the Mosquito Netting(I) onto the Hooks(①).

Affix the Gazebo to the ground by inserting the Stake(⑨) through the Gazebo.
Your Gazebo is ready for use.



















This Gazebo can only be used on a flat, level surface.

Cautions:

1. Check stability and then tighten the Bolts.
2. DO NOT tighten any Bolts fully and then towards the next corner in a similar manner, gradually tighten each Bolt until all Bolts are evenly tightened. ensure maximum evenness once all Bolts are fully tightened.
3. Inspect it and make sure all parts are adequately connected.
4. This Gazebo can only be used on a flat, level surface.

Warning!! If the Gazebo is not Stable, it could lead to danger and cause injury to any occupants.

Care & Maintenance

-   Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.
 -   Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
 -   To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, minimizing exposure to sunlight is recommended.
 -   Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
 -   Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
 -   To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible, store product and/or place under patio or awnings.
 -   Not for commercial use. For residential use only.
 -   Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.

-   Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.

Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

• What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals are found in many products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. This information must be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals.

Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging certain chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer or reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, currently contains over 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

• What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list?

The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals.

in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical exhaust.

- What does a warning mean?

If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing workers to chemicals.

By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is below the risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects.
