Porcelain Tile Installation Guide:

- For a successful installation of your tiles, you need to lay the tiles on a solid base.

Which means removing existing flooring material.

- Porcelain tiles needs to be installed on a levelled floor for the tiles to last longer.

If your floor needs repair, start with repairing and adding support before you start installation.

- After choosing your pattern, map out your installation. You need to find the center of your room. Lay your tiles on the floor to see how the pattern will look before you install them.

Porcelain Tile Installation Guide:

- Start by spreading your thinset with a trowel from the center of your room. Start laying your tile with spacers. Remove your spacers before your thinset dries.
- Clean up any excess thinset, check your tiles leverage by using a tile level.
- You might need to cut your tiles depending on your room size to complete your installation.
- After your tile is set, grout your tile and clean the surface with a damp sponge and clean water.
